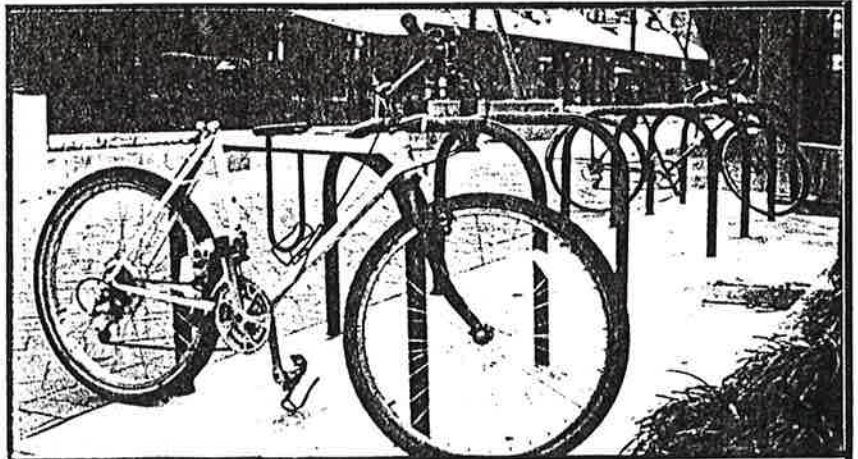

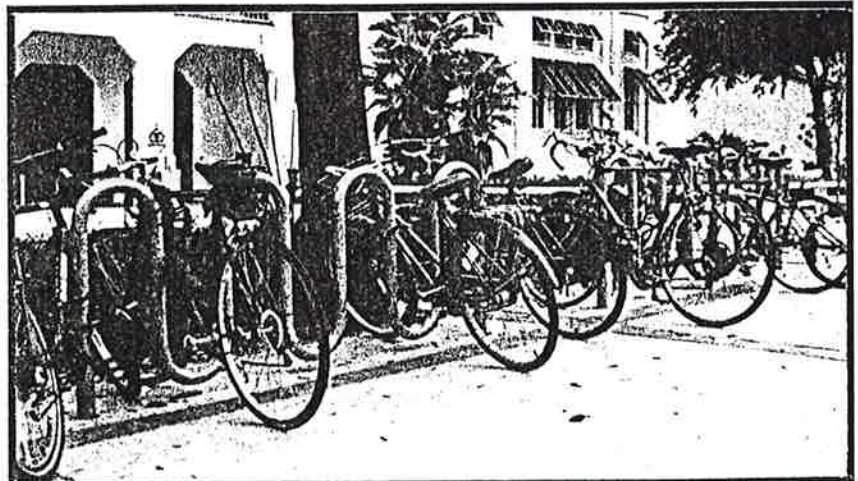

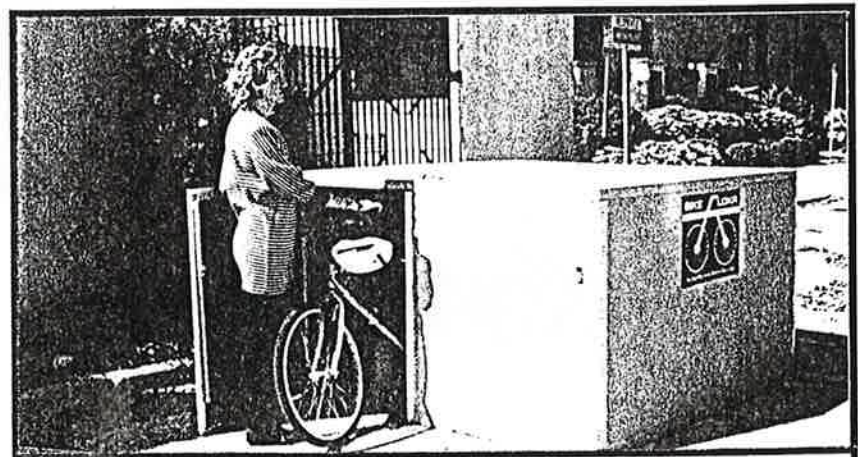

RESOLUTION NO. R-81-100

PASSED November 2, 1981

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN APPROVED LIST OF BICYCLE PARKING DEVICES FOR REQUIRED BICYCLE PARKING FACILITIES PURSUANT TO SECTION 29A-96(a), ZONING CODE OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on October 26, 1981, the City of Gainesville adopted Ordinance No. 2650, the same being a new zoning code; and

WHEREAS, Section 29A-96(a) of the Zoning Code of the City of Gainesville requires the City Commission to adopt an approved list of bicycle parking devices for required bicycle facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City Commission of the City of Gainesville hereby adopts and approves the "List of Bicycle Parking Devices," in accordance with the provisions of Section 29A-96(a), Zoning Code of the City of Gainesville, a copy of which is attached to and made a part hereof as if set forth in full.

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.



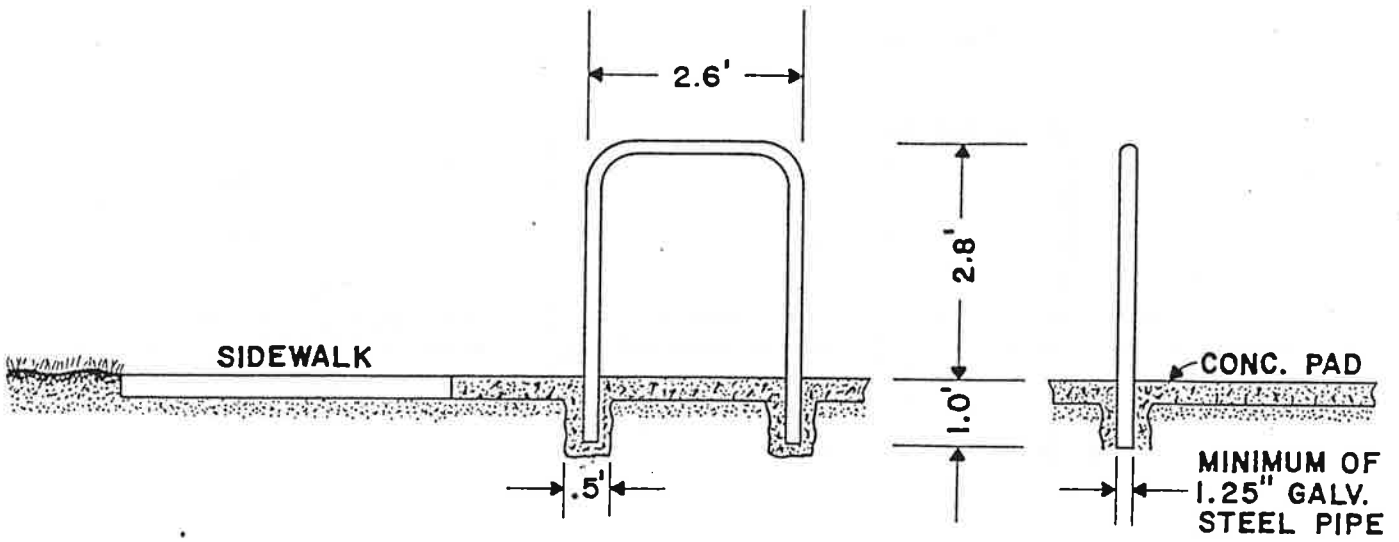

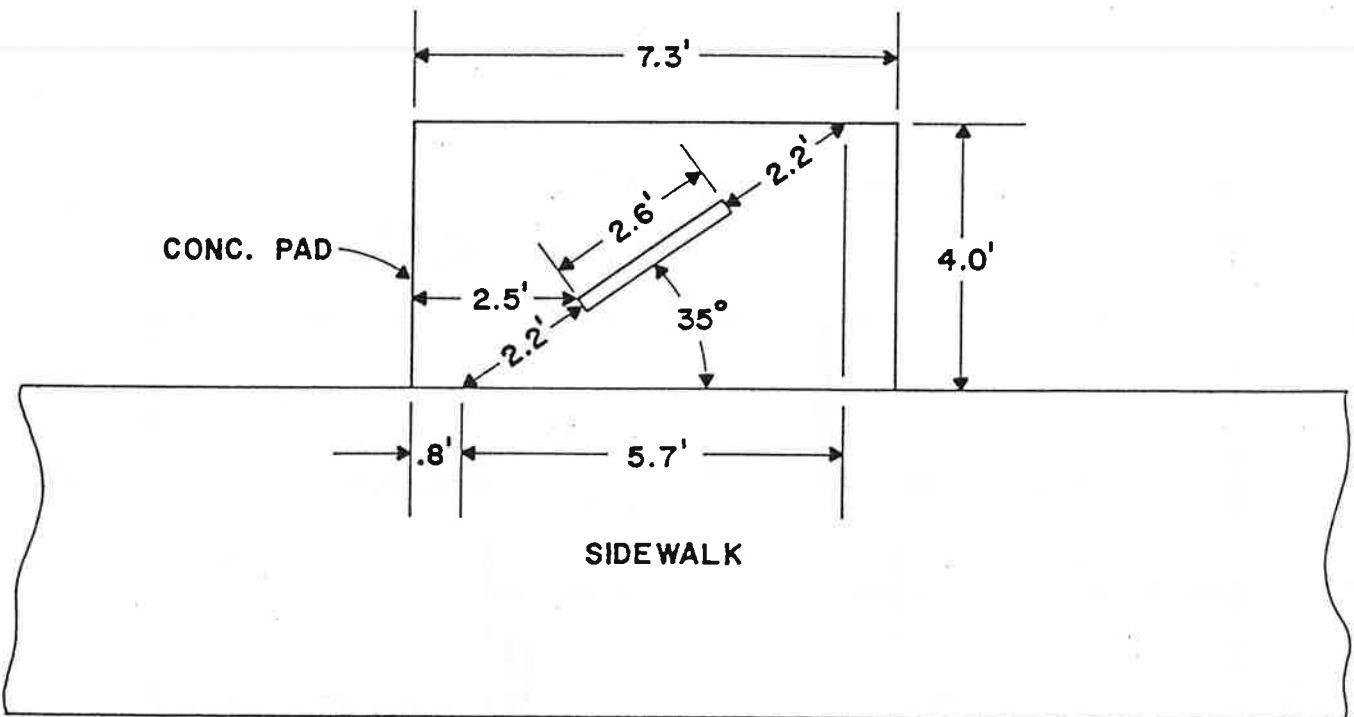

PLAN VIEW

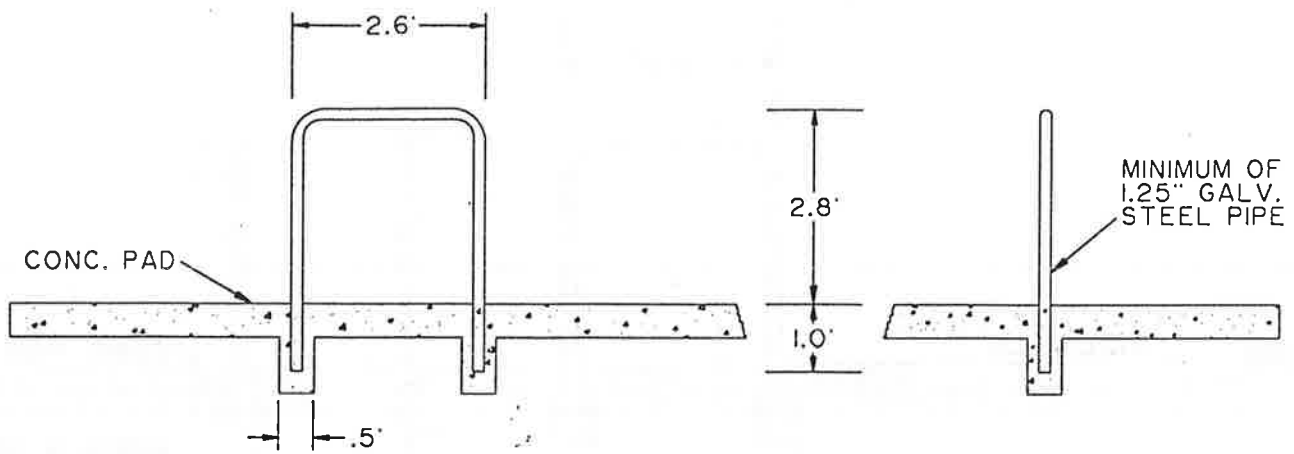

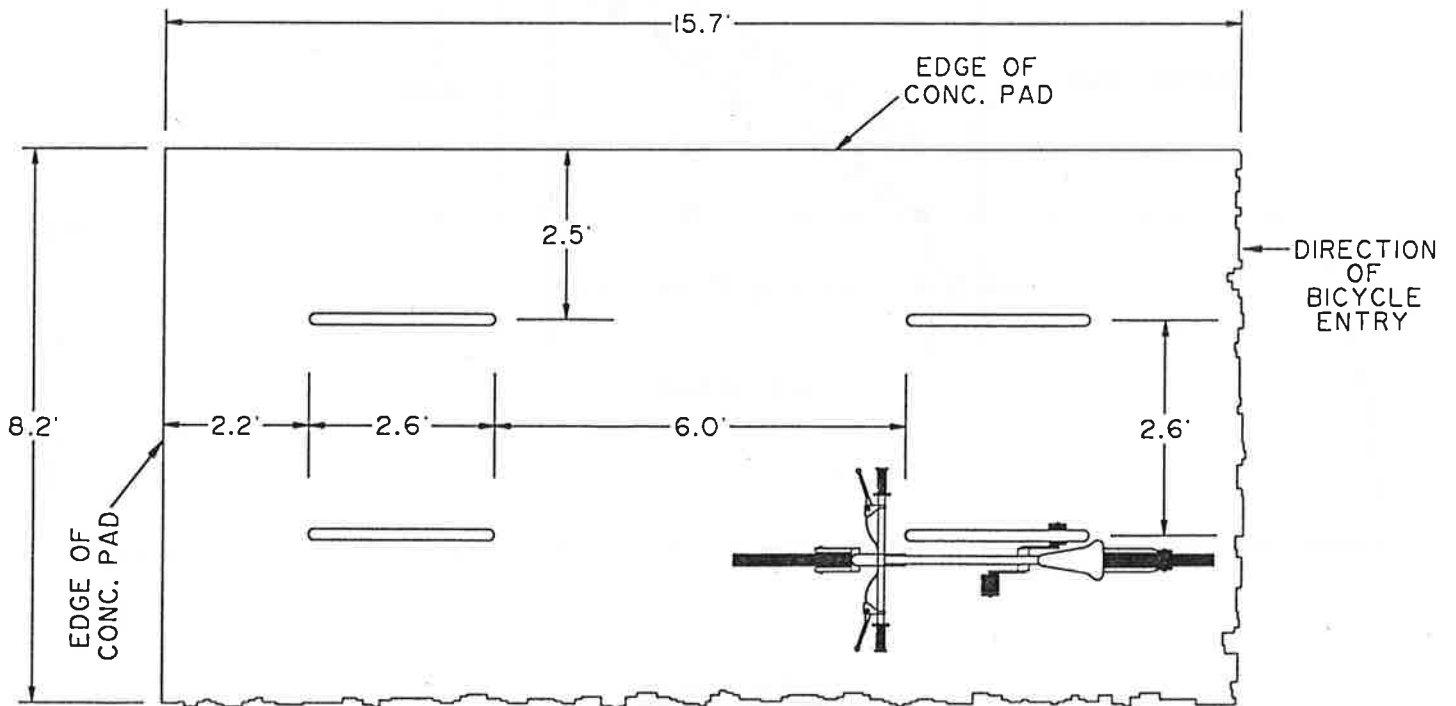
BIKE RACK

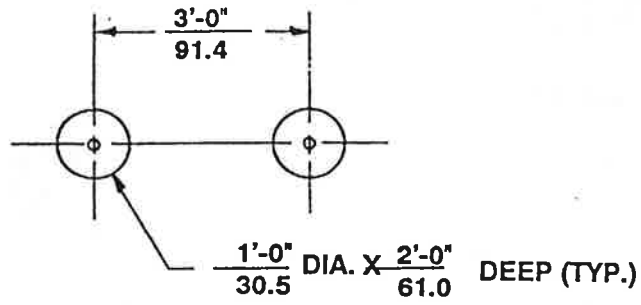

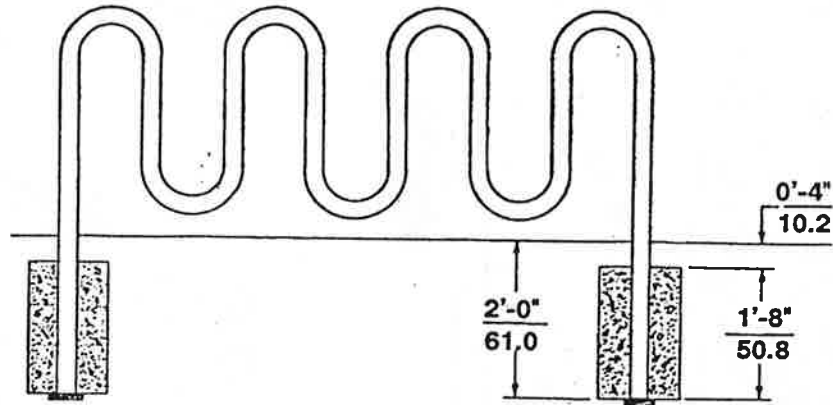
PLAN VIEW

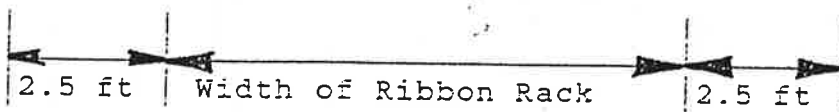
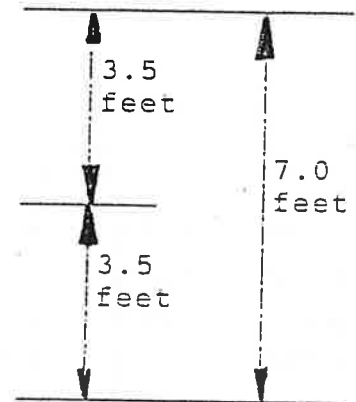
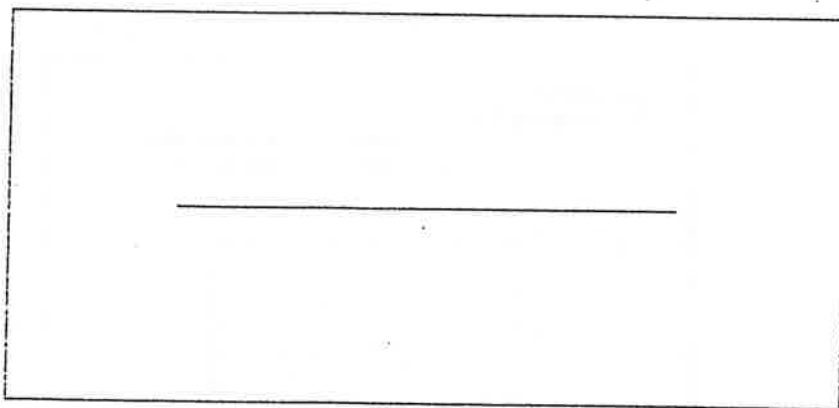

GROUND PLAN



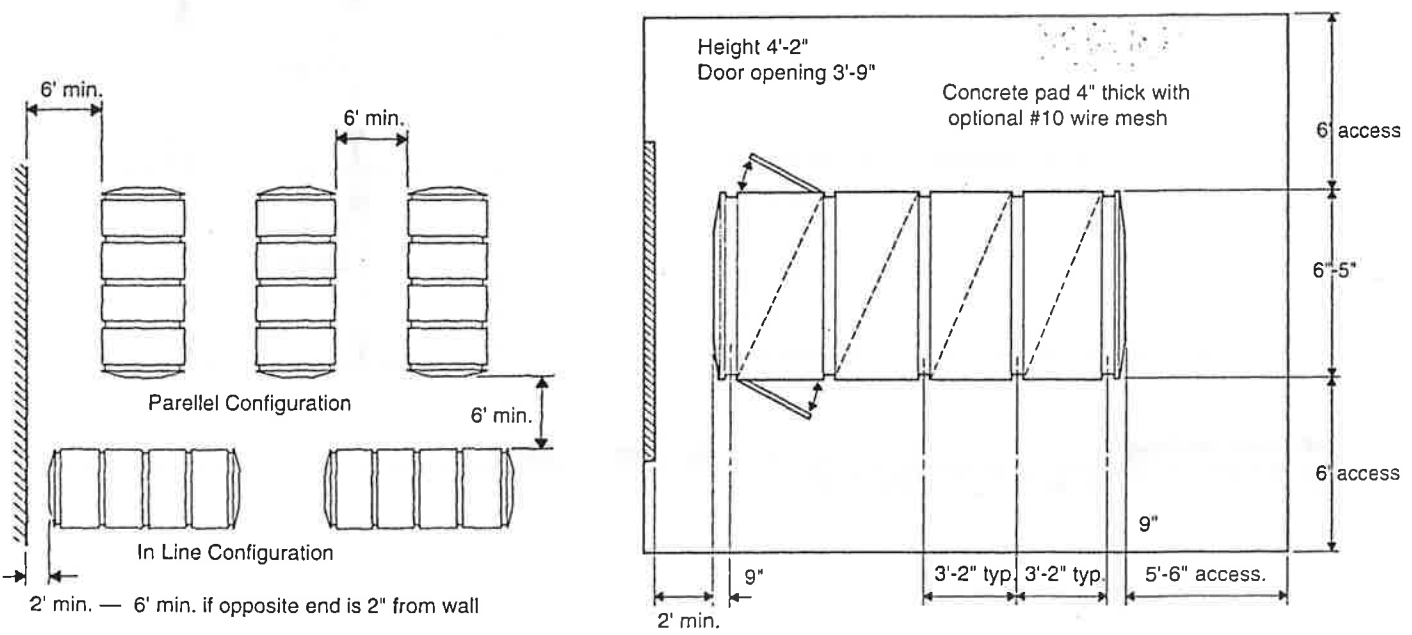
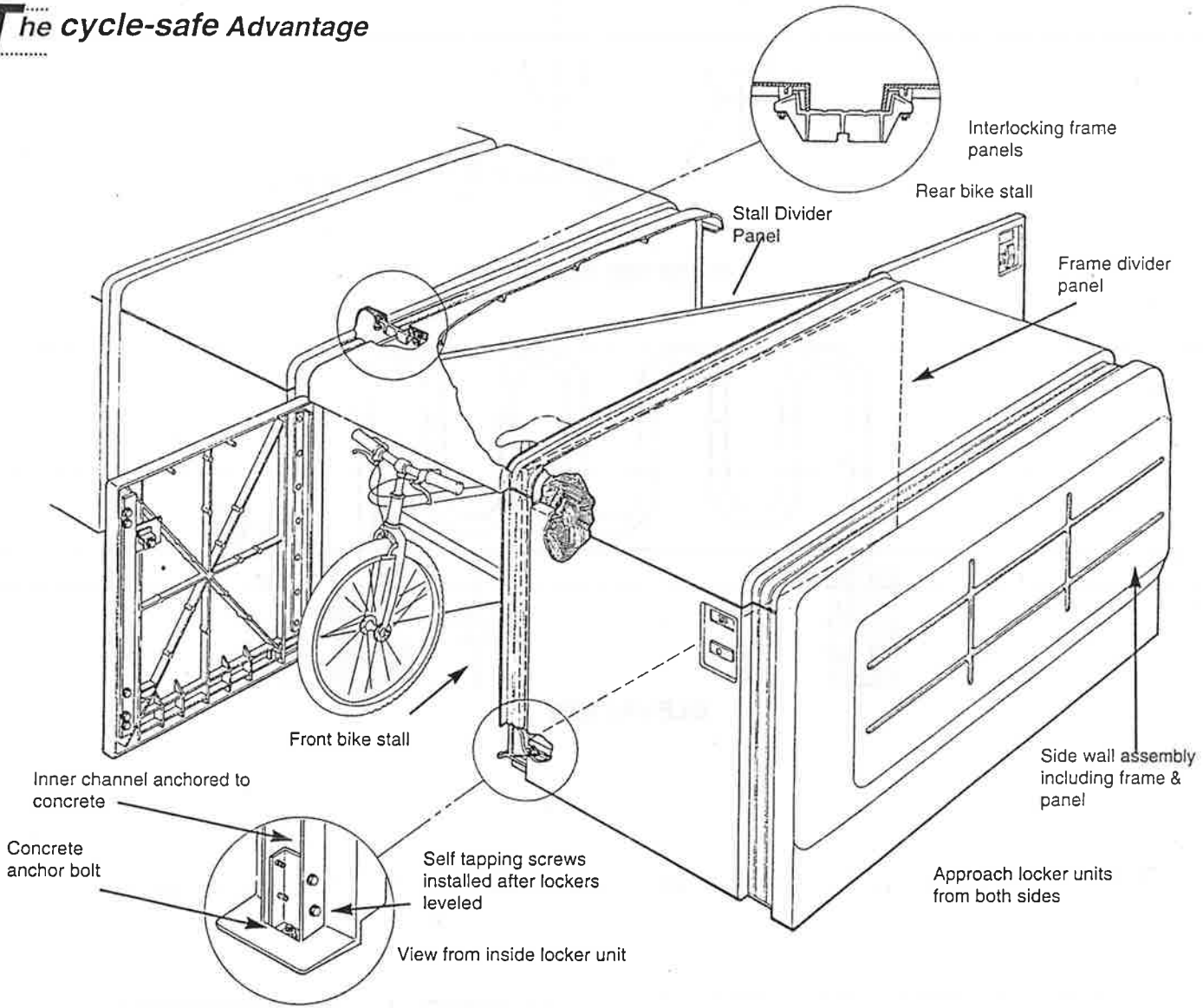
