..explanation

Section 200.065 of the Florida Statutes requires the City Commission to advise the Property Appraiser of its rolled-back millage rate, its proposed millage rate, and of the time, date, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the proposed tentative budget.

..Fiscal Note

The estimated ad-valorem tax revenues as presented in the FY 2002 proposed financial and operating plan include no change in the current millage rate of 4.9416 mills.
