




- > Evaluation

#### Mixed Use Challenges

- ➤ Distinguishing urban from suburban
- Defining scale of activity centers
- > Encouraging desired redevelopment
- ➤ Establishing use mixes
- ➤ Incorporating TND in MU districts
- Increasing densities to support centers







## Scale and Function

- Scale of activity centers
  - ▶ Regional
  - **Community**
  - ▶ Neighborhood
- > Questions:
  - Where large scale retail should be allowed
  - ➤ Suburban v. urban designs
  - ➤ Mixed v. single/multiple use








# Encouraging Desired Redevelopment

- What should trigger standards?
- ➤ How much flexibility for redevelopment?
- ➤ How should non-conformities be addressed?
- What is the best mix of design mandates, incentives and guidelines?





### Establishing Use Mix in MU Districts

- Distinguishing approach to small, large, redevelopment projects
- Establishing standards for horizontal and vertical mix
- > Addressing residential component

### Increasing Densities to Support Centers

- > Requiring mix of uses in center
- > Requiring residential at edge
- > Adding density to abutting neighborhoods

- Analyze potential use of form-based regulation
