ORDINANCE NO. 110110

An Ordinance amending the City of Gainesville ~~2000-2010~~
Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Map; by changing the land use
category of certain property, as more specifically described in this
ordinance, from the Alachua County land use category of
“Commercial” to the City of Gainesville land use category
“Commercial”; consisting of approximately 27.8 acres, and located in
the vicinity of the 7200-7300 block of Northwest 4th Blvd; providing
directions to the City Manager; providing a severability clause;
providing a repealing clause and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, publication of notice of a public hearing was given that the Future Land Use
Map be amended by changing the land use category of certain property from the Alachua County
land use category of “Commercial” to the City of Gainesville land use category “Commercial”; and

WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public
hearing was held by the City Plan Board on April 28, 2011; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10
inches long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this
proposed ordinance and of the public hearing to be held at the transmittal stage in the City
Commission Meeting Room, First Floor, City Hall, in the City of Gainesville at least seven (7)
days after the day the first advertisement was published; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, after the public hearing at the transmittal stage, the City of
Gainesville transmitted copies of this proposed change to the Reviewing Agencies and any other
local government unit or state agency that requested same; and

WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long
was placed in the aforesaid newspaper notifying the public of the second public hearing to be

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1 held at the adoption stage at least five (5) days after the day the second advertisement was
2 published; and

3 WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described
4 above at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were,
5 in fact, heard; and

6 WHEREAS, prior to adoption of this ordinance, the City Commission has considered
7 written comments, if any were received, concerning this plan amendment.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
9 CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

10 Section 1. The Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville ~~2000-2010~~ Comprehensive
11 Plan is amended by changing the land use category of the following described property from the
12 Alachua County land use category of "Commercial" to the City of Gainesville land use category of
13 "Commercial", as more specifically described below:

14 See legal description attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if set
15 forth in full.

16 Section 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to make the necessary changes in
17 maps and other data in the City of Gainesville ~~2000-2010~~ Comprehensive Plan, or element, or
18 portion thereof in order to comply with this ordinance.

19 Section 3. Within 10 days of the transmittal (first) hearing, the City Manager is authorized
20 and directed to transmit a comprehensive plan amendment package, including this ordinance, to the
21 Reviewing Agencies and to any other local government unit or state agency that has filed a written
22 request for same with the City. Within 10 days of the adoption (second) hearing, the City Manager
23 is authorized and directed to transmit a comprehensive plan amendment package, including this

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1 ordinance, to the State Land Planning Agency and to any other Reviewing Agency, local
2 government unit or state agency that filed written comments with the City.

3 **Section 4.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance
4 or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
5 finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given
6 effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the
7 provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

8 **Section 5.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
9 such conflict hereby repealed.

10 **Section 6.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage on second
11 reading; however, the effective date of this plan amendment, if the amendment is not timely
12 challenged, shall be 31 days after the State Land Planning Agency notifies the City that the plan
13 amendment package is complete in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S. If timely challenged,
14 this amendment shall become effective on the date the State Land Planning Agency or the
15 Administration Commission enters a final order determining this adopted amendment to be in
16 compliance in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S. No development orders, development
17 permits, or land uses dependent on this amendment may be issued or commenced before this plan
