16	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF			
17	THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA;			
18	Section 1. Chapter 14.5, Article III, Section 14.5-27, of the Code of Ordinances of			
19	the City of Gainesville, is amended to read as follows:			
20	Sec. 14.5-27. Application for wrecker operator's permit; violations.			
21	(a) No wrecker operator shall engage in trespass towing without first having obtained a			
22	wrecker operator permit from the owner of the company such operator is employed, or such			
23	owner's authorized designee. Each permit will meet the following specifications:			
24	(1) be not less than 2 1/8 inches by 3 3/8 inches.			
25	(2) contain a photograph of the wrecker operator that is not less than one inch by			
26	1 ½ inches in size.			

1	(3)	provide the na	me of the wrecker service and wrecker operator's first name in		
2		letters that are	not less than 1/4 inch by 1/4 inch.		
3	(4)	provide a control number that is linked to the driver's personal information.			
4	(5)	provide a plac	e for the chief of police or designee to validate the permit.		
5		a. After t	he permit is validated it shall be laminated to protect the		
6		inform	ation on the permit.		
7		b. If the p	permit is lost, damaged, stolen, becomes illegible or the permit		
8		holder	changes wrecker services, the permit must be replaced. The		
9		replace	ement permit shall be valid only for the remainder of the time		
10		period	for which the initial permit was valid.		
11	(b) It shall be unlawful for the owner of any wrecker service to permit any person to be				
12	employed as	wrecker opera	tor conducting trespass towing within the city unless such		
13	person has been granted a wrecker operator permit to engage in trespass towing which has				
14	been validated by the chief of police or designee. Upon issuance of the permit, the wrecker				
15	operator is gr	nted the privile	ege of engaging in trespass towing within the city limits of the		
16	City of Gaine	ville, Florida, ı	unless such permit expires or is suspended or revoked, as		
17	provided in the	is Article. Each	h permit shall be valid for two years from date of issuance.		
18	(c) In ord	er to secure a w	recker operator permit, an applicant must provide the following		
19	information o	a form provid	ed by the city. The applicant must:		
20	(1)	Submit to the	chief of police or designee a certified copy from the Florida		
21		Department of	Law Enforcement of his/her criminal history and a certified		
22		copy of his/he	r driving record from the Florida Department of Highway		
23		Safety and Mo	otor Vehicles;		

1	(2)	Possess a valid Florida Class E driver's license and provide a photocopy to			
2		the chief of police or designee.			
3	(3)	Not have been convicted, pled nolo contendere to, or had adjudication			
4		withheld for any of the following:			
5		a. Within the previous ten years, Aany violent felony including rape	,		
6		battery, aggravated battery, felony battery and aggravated assault.			
7		b. Within the previous ten years, any felony or first degree misdemes	anor		
8		directly related to the business of towing motor vehicles; reposses	sion		
9		of motor vehicles; motor vehicle theft; car jacking or chop shops;	or		
10		liens for recovering, towing, or storing vehicles and vessels (§713	.78,		
11		F.S.).			
12		e. Within the previous five years, of either: (1) driving under the			
13		influence of alcohol, a controlled substance, or a chemical substan	ıce,		
14		to the extent that normal faculties are impaired; or (2) driving with	h an		
15		unlawful blood alcohol level.			
16	(d) A peri	it shall be reviewed and granted or denied in writing within two business			
17	days. If the permit is denied, the reason for such denial shall be provided in writing and				
18	shall also adv	e that the applicant may correct deficiencies in the application within 7 da	ays		
19	of the notice of denial without incurring an additional application fee.				
20	(e) Permi	ees shall be as provided in Appendix A, Schedule of Fees, Rates and			
21	Charges.				
22	Section	2. It is the intention that Section 1 of this ordinance shall become and be m	nade		
23	a part of the Code of Ordinances, of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and				

1	Paragraphs of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such				
2	intentions.				
3	Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be				
4	invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no				
5	way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.				
6	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent				
7	of such conflict hereby repealed.				
8	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately on adoption
