Passed: July 1, 2010

A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, authorizing the City Manager to execute a Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Gainesville and Alachua County granting the City of Gainesville maintenance responsibility for the proposed traffic signal at the intersection of SR 24 and the proposed SW 40th Boulevard extension.

WHEREAS, Alachua County is preparing to undertake a Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Local Area Project which is known as the SW 62nd Boulevard Interim Projects, in Gainesville, Florida, which will be of benefit to the City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, FDOT will initially install the traffic signal; and


WHEREAS, FDOT is requiring Alachua County to agree to maintain all traffic signalization equipment considered non-standard by FDOT for that portion of this project that is located within the FDOT Right-of-Way at the intersection of SR No. 24 (Archer Road) and SW 40th Boulevard (the intersection); and

WHEREAS, the intersection is located within the city limits of the City

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, authorizing the acceptance and approval of a Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Gainesville and the Florida Department of Transportation granting the City of Gainesville maintenance responsibility for the proposed traffic signal at the intersection of SR 24 and the proposed SW 40th Boulevard extension.


