Summarize characteristics of Juvenile Offenses
- Increase awareness of Annual Juvenile Offense Data
- Share information with other juvenile justice service providers

# 2006 Juvenile Offense Data Introduction

- ✓ Data reflects 2,377 offenses entered into SAO STAC in which a juvenile committed an offense between January 1 and December 31, 2006 in Alachua county (2,150 offenses in 2005)
- ✓ Total Number of offenses committed by 1,498 youth.
  - ✓ 1,091 youth were charged with only one offense,
  - ✓ 407 youth committed 2 or more offenses,
  - ✓ 8 youth committed 10 or more offenses.

\* The total number of 2005 juvenile offenses were committed by 1,387 juveniles; 1,021 youth were charged with only one offense in 2005, 366 youth committed 2 or more offenses, only 3 youth committed 12 or more offenses.

# Types of Offenses: Categories

## ■ Property

Criminal Mischief, Burglary, Theft (petit, retail, grand), Fraudulent use of credit card, Forgery, Arson, Dealing in stolen property

## ■ Personal

Domestic violence, Robbery, Affray, Battery, Assault, Resisting arrest w/ violence, Kidnapping, Culpable negligence, Attempted carjacking with a weapon

- **Sex Crime** Sexual Battery, lewd and lascivious, indecent exposure, voyeurism
- **Gun** Firearm related offense
- **Dom** Domestic battery or assault

## ■ Other

Disorderly conduct, Trespassing, loitering, resisting arrest w/o violence, Giving False Information, disrupting a school function, possession of weapon at school, Juvenile escape, cruelty to animals.

## ■ Drug

Alcohol or other illegal Drug offense (possession, sale or paraphernalia)

## ■ Multiple types of offenses

Case involves multiple charges involving a Combination of offenses which include at least one property or one personal offense category
