- Section 1. The Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive
 Plan is amended by changing the land use category of the following described property from the
 Alachua County land use category of "Rural/Agriculture" to the City of Gainesville land use
 category of "Conservation":
- See legal description attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof as if set forth in full.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to make the necessary changes in maps and other data in the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan, or element, or portion thereof in order to comply with this ordinance.
- Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such

- 1 finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given
- 2 effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the
- 3 provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
- Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
- Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage; however, the amendment to the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan shall become effective thirty one (31) days after passage and adoption of this Ordinance unless a petition is filed with the Division of Administrative Hearings pursuant to § 163.3187(3), F.S. In this event this Ordinance shall not become effective until the state land planning agency issues a final order determining the adopted amendment to be in compliance in accordance with § 163.3187, or until the Administration
