1 ORDINANCE NO.: 070058 2 0-07-50 3 4 An Ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida; adopting an Urban 5 Services Report which sets forth the plans to provide urban services to an area owned by the City of Gainesville and comprised of Tax 6 Parcels 06909-001-001, 06909-001-002, 06909-001-003, 06909-7 001-004, 06909-001-005, and 06909-001-006, generally located 8 south of the City Limits and Tax Parcel 06909-000-000, west of Tax 9 Parcels 06911-025-000 and 06911-026-000, north of SW 46th Place 10 and east of Tax Parcel 06909-002-000; the area is proposed for 11 annexation by the City of Gainesville pursuant to Chapter 90-496, 12 Special Acts, Laws of Florida, as amended, known as the Alachua 13 County Boundary Adjustment Act; providing directions to the City 14 Manager, the City Attorney and the Clerk of the Commission; 15 providing a repealing clause; providing a severability clause; and 16 17 providing an immediate effective date. 18 19 20 WHEREAS, Chapter 90-496, Special Acts, Laws of Florida, created the "Alachua County Boundary Adjustment Act" which sets forth procedures for establishing municipal reserve areas and 21 22 for adjusting the boundaries of municipalities through annexations; and WHEREAS. Chapter 90-496 was amended by Chapter 91-382 and Chapter 93-347, 23 Special Acts, Laws of Florida, (hercinafter collectively referred to as "the Act") which requires a 24 municipality to prepare and adopt by nonemergency ordinance, a report setting forth the plans to 25 provide urban services to any reserve area prior to commencing the annexation procedures under 26 the Act; and 27 WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville is planning to commence the annexation of certain 28 unincorporated areas that are owned and used by the City of Gainesville, as more specifically 29 30 described in this Ordinance, and that are located within its Reserve Area as defined in the Act and

as redesignated by the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County; and

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1	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, at least ten days notice has been given prior to adoption by
2	publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed Ordinance
3	and of a Public Hearing to be held in the City Commission meeting room, First Floor, City Hall, in
4	the City of Gainesville; and
5	WHEREAS, Public Hearings were held pursuant to law, at which hearings the parties in
6	interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact heard.
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
8	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
9	Section 1. The Urban Services Report, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A" and
10	incorporated herein as if set forth in full, sets forth the plans to provide urban services to an area
11	comprised of Tax Parcels 06909-001-001, 06909-001-002, 06909-001-003, 06909-001-004, 06909-
12	001-005, and 06909-001-006, generally located south of the City Limits and Tax Parcel 06909-000-
13	000, west of Tax Parcels 06911-025-000 and 06911-026-000, north of SW 46 th Place and east of
14	Tax Parcel 06909-002-000; and is hereby approved and adopted for that certain area as more
15	specifically described in the Urban Services Report.
16	Section 2. The City Manager is directed to file a copy of this Ordinance and the
17	accompanying Urban Services Report with the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County
18	and to commence the annexation of the area defined in the Urban Services Report. The City
19	Attorney and Clerk of the Commission are authorized to prepare and advertise the appropriate

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ordinance(s).

1	Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid
2	or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect
3	the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
4	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
5	such conflict hereby repealed.
6	Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
