WHEREAS, Rosa Jouise McCauly Parks was born on February 4, 1913 in Tuskegee, Alabama and, as a young woman, dedicated herself to service to her community, to the local NAACP, and was a devoted wife to husband, Raymond, a model citizen and loyal friend; and

WHEREAS, Rosa Parks advocated education and community involvement in order to improve the lot of African-Americans in the segregated South; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Parks, through her tireless efforts and unwavering principles, refused to allow herself and others to be treated as second-class citizens in America because of the color of their skin; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Parks displayed quiet courage and dignity on December 1, 1955 on a Montgomery, Alabama segregated city bus when she refused to give her seat to a white passenger, according to the city ordinance, and was removed from the bus and arrested; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Parks actions led to a city-wide bus boycott that led to the beginnings of the modern day civil-rights movement that changed the nation and the world, and led to the emergence of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., as a national leader and Nobel Peace prize winner; and

WHEREAS, in order to give due respect and honor to Rosa Parks and the legacy she leaves behind in her passing, the Alachua County Commission invites all residents of Alachua County to recognize and participate in "Rosa Parks Day".

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Pegeen Hanrahan, by the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Gainesville, do hereby proclaim December 1, 2005 as

Rosa Parks Day

in the City of Gainesville and invite all our citizens to join me in celebrating the life and legacy of Rosa Parks, recipient of the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 1996, for her contribution to history and to the struggle for peace, justice and freedom for our nation and throughout the entire world.
