Processed approximately 99 Certificate of Appropriateness applications in 2007. Of the 1354 applications the Historic Preservation Board has heard since 1990, it has approved over 98%. Staff approved over 68% of all petitions in 2007.

Approved 4 Ad Valorem Tax Exemption applications.
