3 4 5	An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, adding certain specified real properties owned in fee simple by the City of
6 7 8 9	Gainesville to the City of Gainesville Registry of Protected Public Places, as more specifically described in this Ordinance; adopting findings; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
11	WHEREAS, the City Commission on December 18, 2009, passed an ordinance
12	submitting to the electorate of the City of Gainesville a Charter Amendment to the
13	Charter Laws of the City of Gainesville creating a new Article V titled "Sale or
14	conversion of City-owned lands used or acquired for conservation, recreation, or cultural
15	purposes"; and
16	WHEREAS, at the municipal election held on March 24, 2009, the electorate of
17	the City of Gainesville approved a New Article V of the Charter Laws of the City of
18	Gainesville, Florida entitled "Sale or conversion of City-owned lands used or acquired
19	for conservation, recreation, or cultural purposes"; and
20	WHEREAS, at a regularly scheduled City Commission meeting held on March 3,
21	2011, the commission heard and approved the recommendation of the Recreation,
22	Cultural Affairs and Public Works Committee to add specified City-owned properties to
23	the City of Gainesville Registry of Protected Public Places; and
24	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a
25	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a
26	public hearing to be held in the City Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of
27	Gainesville; and

1	WHEREAS, the Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice
2	described at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be
3	and were, in fact, heard.
4	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION
5	OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
6	Section 1. The real properties or portions of real properties that are owned in fee
7	simple by the City of Gainesville and that were acquired or are used for conservation,
8	recreation, or cultural purposes, listed in Exhibit "A", attached hereto, are added to the
9	City of Gainesville Registry of Protected Public Places.
10 11 12 13	See legal descriptions of Phase I Registry Listings and descriptions of the values that support inclusion of each site as set forth Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a apart hereof as if set forth in full.
14	Section 2. The record presented to the city commission on March 3, 2011 (ID
15	100523, City of Gainesville Registry of Protected Places Listing (b)), provides additional
16	detailed information on the values for which the property was placed on the registry and
17	that record is incorporated herein by reference.
18	Section 3. The City Commission finds that the City's present or future use of
19	these properties as described in "Exhibit A" may be used for any conservation,
20	recreation, or cultural public purposes without resulting in any loss of any stated value or
21	values.
22	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the
23	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
24	Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
