## **Policy 2.6.1**

The School Board shall annually update and amend the 5-Year District Facilities Work Program to reflect the (LOS) standards for schools to add a new fifth year, which continues to achieve and maintain the adopted LOS for schools. The 5-Year District Facilities Work Program ensures that the level of service standards for public schools are achieved and maintained within the period covered by the 5-year schedule of capital improvements. The 5-Year Work Program shall also address the correction of existing facility deficiencies and facilities needed to meet future needs. After the first 5-year schedule of capital improvements, annual updates to the schedule shall ensure that the LOS is achieved and maintained within the subsequent 5-year schedules of capital necessary to improvements address existing deficiencies and meet future needs based upon achieving and maintaining the adopted level of service standards. The City shall have neither obligation nor responsibility for funding the 5-Year District Facilities Work Program by including it in the Capital Improvements Element of the City's Comprehensive Plan.

## **Policy 2.4.8**

In the event that the School Board determines that there is not sufficient capacity in the affected concurrency service area or an adjacent concurrency service area to address the impacts of a proposed development, the following standards shall apply. Either (1) the site plan or final subdivision must provide capacity enhancement sufficient to meet its impacts through proportionate share mitigation per Objective 2.5; or (2) the site plan or final subdivision when be delayed to date a enhancement and level of service can be assured.; or (3) a condition of approval of the site plan or final subdivision shall be that the project's development plan and/or building permits shall be delayed to a date when capacity enhancement and level of service can be assured.
