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Roy - I attended Mr. Pearce Neighborhood special meeting as an observer. Including my self, there were only 19 people present.

More than half of the people at his meeting were not from the neighborhood. I REPEAT, More Than Half of the People in attendance were not from our Neighborhoods.

I and one other person from the neighborhood did not vote. I did not vote because we the VICTIMS and REFUGEES of KOPPERS and BEAZER EAST do not recognize Mr. Pearce or his group as a spoke person or as our representative in any way shape or form.

Other than my self, I did not see any of the hundreds of Victims and Refugees that I Know from the neighborhood.

Who does Mr. Pearce think he is? To Speak For Us! Or to Make any recommendation on our behalf and to lie saying that we don't want Permanent relocation.

We have been suffering for decades here, testifying about our illnesses and death for decades, coming to this commission meetings and begging, pleading for compassion, environmental justice and permanent relocation.

Mr. Pearce moved into our neighborhood nearly 6 years ago and he speaks for me and the 14 member of my house hold that have died!? NO He DOSEN'T!

Does Mr. Pearce, He speaks for all of my neighbors that

have died and their families? NO HE DOSEN'T!

Does Mr. Pearce Speak for all the Children and their Families that had to abandon their homes for their SAFETY? NO HE DOSEN'T!

Does Mr. Pearce Speak for all the Koppers Refugees that abandon their homes leaving their entire toxic and contaminated household belongings behind, and of the financial cost and stress that these families are suffering? NO HE DOESEN'T

Does Mr. Pearce Know how much pain and suffering we have and continue to endure because of the Koppers contamination? NO HE DOSEN'T

Mr. Pearce is not our representative, or SPEAKS for us. I and the hundreds of Victims that I know never voted for Mr. Pearce or his proposal.

Gainesville is a sick and Toxic City and Mr. Pearce and his kind make it even more toxic. Too many are suffering, to many are sick, to many have died and many more will die.

These ongoing human rights violations that continue to be inflicted on a wounded community here in Gainesville Florida, in the good old USA, is Un-American and Unacceptable
