5 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF  
6 GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA; RELATING TO THE LEVY OF GENERAL  
7 MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2000-2001 FISCAL  
8 YEAR; ESTABLISHING A PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE; SETTING A PUBLIC  
9 HEARING; PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF NOTICE; AND  
10 PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

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12 WHEREAS, on July 31, 2000, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, adopted  
13 Resolution No. 000215, which approved a proposed tentative general operating and financial plan for the City of  
14 Gainesville, Florida; and

15 WHEREAS, on July 31, 2000, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 000214 approving the  
16 proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative general purpose municipal budget; and

17 WHEREAS, pursuant to law and utilizing the rates established in the said resolutions on July 31, 2000, the  
18 Alachua County Property Appraiser mailed a Notice of Proposed Property Taxes to each taxpayer listed on the  
19 current year's assessment roll; and

20 WHEREAS, the said Notice of Proposed Property Taxes advised the recipients of a public hearing to be  
21 conducted by the City Commission for consideration of its tentative general operating and financial plan budget and  
22 the proposed millage necessary to fund the said budget; and

23 WHEREAS, the public hearing has been held as specified in the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes and in  
24 accordance with applicable law; and

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF  
26 GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

27 1. The proposed operating millage rate of 4.9416 mills to fund the amended tentative general operating  
28 and financial plan budget for the City of Gainesville's 2000-2001 fiscal year is hereby approved for further  
29 consideration in accordance with applicable law.

30 2. The general fund operating millage rate approved herein is more than the rolled-back rate by .1769  
31 which results in a 3.71 percent increase in property taxes.

32 3. A public hearing will be held to consider the final millage rate and budget for general municipal  
33 purposes on Monday, the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2000, at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be

1 heard, in the City Hall Auditorium on the first floor of City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, City of Gainesville,  
2 Florida.

3 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and publish all necessary and required  
4 notices prior to the hearing established herein, and to provide copies of this resolution to all parties as may be  
5 required by applicable law.

6 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
