





CREEK CROSSING EVALUATION


Identify measures that will restore historic characteristics & functionality of the creek floodplain areas north and south of NW 8th Ave while achieving the following objectives:


- Minimize capital and maintenance costs associated with erosion and sediment accumulation in the Creeks.
- Minimize flood risk to the roadway and homes in the area.
- Minimize environmental impacts to the creeks and adjacent floodplain.




















CREEK CROSSING EVALUATION

Proposed Actions	Estimated Cost
1. Relief culverts to replicate historical flow patterns and corresponding road restoration	\$1,985,000
2. Possum Creek Headwall Stabilization & Repair	\$325,000
3. Hogtown Creek Culvert Stabilization & Sediment Removal	\$575,000
4. Watershed Management Planning	TBD – Future Phase






two lane, two way mostly undivided


