RESOLUTION

SUBJECT:

A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida; relating to the levy of general municipal purpose ad valorem taxes for the 2005-2006 fiscal year; establishing a proposed millage rate; establishing a public hearing; providing for notice to the Alachua County Property Appraiser; providing an

immediate effective date.

Recommendation: The City Commission adopt the proposed resolution.

Section 200.065 of the Florida Statutes requires the City Commission to advise the Property Appraiser of its rolled-back millage rate, its proposed millage rate, and of the time, date, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the proposed tentative budget.

The estimated ad-valorem tax revenues as presented in the FY 2006 Proposed Financial and Operating Plan – Budget by Funds is based on the current millage rate of 4.9416 mills and not on the rolled-back millage rate of 4.4877 mills.

23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE

25	Section 1. The rolled-back millage rate for the general municipal purpose, as computed
26	pursuant to Section 200.065 (1), Florida Statutes, is 4.4877 mills.
27	Section 2. The proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative
28	general purpose municipal budget for the City of Gainesville's 2005-2006 fiscal year is 4.9416
29	mills.

1	Section 3. A public hearing will be held to consider the proposed miliage rate and the
2	proposed tentative budget for general municipal purposes on Monday, September 12, 2005, at six
3	o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City Hall Auditorium on the
4	first floor of City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, City of Gainesville, Florida.
5	Section 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of this
6	resolution to the Alachua County Property Appraiser for use in preparing the Notice of Proposed
7	Property Taxes, as required by Section 200.069, Florida Statutes, and to execute, as the
8	Administering Official, any Department of Revenue forms necessary to complete this
9	certification.
10	Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
