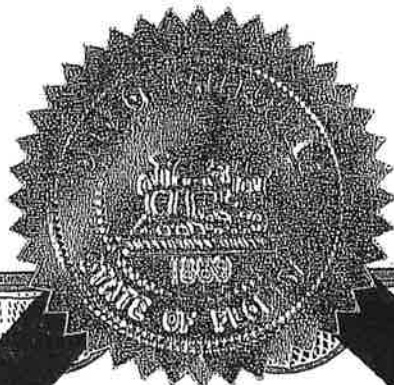
WHEREAS, all citizens are invited to attend this ceremony to express their support and appreciation to our veterans both living and deceased.
