16	adopted Resolution No. 001594, which approved a proposed tentative general operating and
17	financial plan for the City of Gainesville, Florida; and
18	WHEREAS, on July 23, 2001, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 001593
19	approving the proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative general purpose
20	municipal budget; and
21	WHEREAS, pursuant to law and utilizing the rates established in the said resolutions on
22	July 23, 2001, the Alachua County Property Appraiser mailed a Notice of Proposed Property
23	Taxes to each taxpayer listed on the current year's assessment roll; and
24	WHEREAS, the said Notice of Proposed Property Taxes advised the recipients of a
25	public hearing to be conducted by the City Commission for consideration of its tentative general
26	operating and financial plan budget and the proposed millage necessary to fund the said budget;

28	WHEREAS, the public hearing has been held as specified in the Notice of Proposed
29	Property Taxes and in accordance with applicable law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE

CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- 1. The proposed operating millage rate of 4.9416 mills to fund the amended tentative
- 4 general operating and financial plan budget for the City of Gainesville's 2001-2002 fiscal year is
- 5 hereby approved for further consideration in accordance with applicable law.
- 6 2. The general fund operating millage rate approved herein is more than the rolled-back
- 7 rate by .3220 mills which results in a 6.97% increase in property taxes.
- 8 3. A public hearing will be held to consider the final millage rate and budget for general
- 9 municipal purposes on Monday, the 24th day of September, 2001, at 6:00 p.m., or as soon
- thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City Hall Auditorium on the first floor of City Hall,
- 11 200 East University Avenue, City of Gainesville, Florida.
- 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and publish all
- 13 necessary and required notices prior to the hearing established herein, and to provide copies of
- this resolution to all parties as may be required by applicable law.
 - 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
