A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA; RELATING TO THE LEVY OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2005-2006 FISCAL YEAR; ESTABLISHING A PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE; SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING; PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF NOTICE; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2005, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, adopted Resolution No. 050186, which approved a Proposed Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville, Florida; and

,

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2005, the City Commission adopted Resolution

No. 050188 approving the proposed millage rate necessary to fund the Proposed

Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law and utilizing the rates established in the said resolution on or about August 12, 2005, the Alachua County Property Appraiser mailed a Notice of Proposed Property Taxes to each taxpayer listed on the current year's assessment roll; and

WHEREAS, the said Notice of Proposed Property Taxes advised the recipients of a public hearing to be conducted by the City Commission for consideration of its Amended Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget and the proposed millage necessary to fund the said budget; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing has been held as specified in the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes and in accordance with applicable law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- 1. The proposed operating millage rate of 4.9416 mills to fund the Amended Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville's 2005-2006 fiscal year is hereby approved for further consideration in accordance with applicable law.
- 2. The General Fund operating millage rate approved herein is more than the rolled-back rate by .4539 mill which results in a 10.11% increase in property taxes.
- 3. A public hearing will be held to consider the final millage rate and budget for general municipal purposes on Monday, the 26th day of September, 2005, at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City Hall Auditorium on the first floor of City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, City of Gainesville, Florida.
- 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and publish all necessary and required notices prior to the hearing established herein, and to provide copies of this resolution to all parties as may be required by applicable law.
 - 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
