1	Section 5. Sec. 2-212 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gamesvine is

4	(a) The departr	nent of community development Planning and Development
5	Services sha	all be divided into four three separate divisions areas as follows:
6	(1	A planning division under a chief planner planning manager,
7		which division shall be responsible for comprehensive and
8		current planning and eapital programming concurrency
9		management throughout the city.
10	(2	A building division under a building inspector official which wil
11		enforce all provisions of the building code, issue building
12		permits, conduct required inspections, and shall be the enforcing
13		arm and official of the zoning and building codes. All
14		responsibilities for the performance of these functions which
15		heretofore were under the department of public works are hereby
16		transferred to the department of community development under
17		this division.
18	(3	A housing division under a housing inspector who shall enforce
19		the housing code, the mobile home housing code and other rules
20		and regulations of the city pertaining to the construction and
21		maintenance of places used or intended for human habitation.
22		This division shall be the enforcing arm and official of the
23		housing code and other related codes. A planning and

1	development services division which will consist of overall		
2	administrative functions as well as economic development		
3	functions including the following: management of the		
4	Technology Enterprise Center, administration of the Enterprise		
5	Zone Program, development activities associated with Airport		
6	Industrial Park, Small Business Development activities, and all		
7	other duties as the city manager may assign from time to time.		
8	(4) An urban renewal division under a division chief or supervisor		
9	who shall be responsible for rehabilitation and redevelopment		
10	programs of all kinds in which the city may be or become		
11	engaged.		
12	(b) Additional divisions of the department of community development Planning		
13	and Development Services may be created from time to time by ordinance and		
14	the several responsibilities of each division may be added to, amended,		
15	transferred to another division or reorganized in such fashion as from time to		
16	time may be determined necessary by the city commission.		
17	Section 4. Sec. 2-213 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is		
18	amended as follows:		
19	Sec. 2-213. Duties and responsibilities.		
20	The department of community development Planning and Development Services shall be		
21	the administrative department of the city government charged with the responsibility of		
22	performing the several clerical, investigative, inspection and other administrative duties		
23	for the city plan board, board of adjustment, eity housing board, the board of electrical		

1	examiners, the board of plumbing examiners, the building code advisory committee,
2	development review board, historic preservation board, Gainesville Enterprise Zone
3	Development Agency and such other boards or committees as the city manager may from
4	time to time designate and shall relate their activities to making studies and
5	recommendations on matters that are under the supervision of the department of
6	community development Planning and Development Services.
7	Section 5. The Codifier is directed to change the name Community Development
8	Department or Department of Community Development to Planning and Development
9	Services wherever the same appears in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville,
10	Florida.
11	Section 6. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of
12	Sections 1 through 4 shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the
13	City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the sections and paragraphs of this ordinance may
14	be renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.
15	Section 7. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this
16	ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or
17	unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the
18	ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or
19	application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
20	Section 8. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the
21	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
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1	Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
