PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, emergency services is a vital public service provided by Gainesville Fire Rescue; and

WHEREAS, the members of Gainesville Fire Rescue and Gainesville's Emergency Medical Services partners are ready to provide timely Advanced Life Support to those in need 24 hours a day, seven days a week during natural and man-made disasters; and

WHEREAS, rapid access to quality emergency care and continuity of care from CPR/First Aid trained community members who have enrolled in the PulsePoint program and first responders dramatically improves the survival and recovery rate of those who experience sudden illness or injury; and

WHEREAS, the scope of Emergency Medical Services provided by Gainesville Fire Rescue is growing to fill a need of the citizens by providing a bevy of out of hospital care including preventative medicine assistance, follow-up care plans, and assistance in accessing social services through Gainesville Fire Rescue's Community Resource Paramedicine Program; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Medical Services system consists of trained members of the public, first responders, Emergency Medical Technicians, Paramedics, emergency medical dispatchers, Nurses, Physicians Assistants, physicians, educators, administrators, other medical care providers, and staff; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the value and accomplishments of the Emergency Medical Services in Gainesville by designating Emergency Medical Services Week and this year's theme of "Stronger Together".


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Lauren Poe, by the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Gainesville, do hereby proclaim May 20-26, 2018 as
