12	WHEREAS, publication of notice of a public hearing was given that the text of the Land
13	Development Code of the City of Gainesville, Florida, be amended; and
14	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public
15	hearing was then held by the City Plan Board on June 24, 2010; and
16	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10
17	inches long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of the Public
18	Hearing to be held in the City Commission Meeting Room, First Floor, City Hall, in the City of
19	Gainesville at least seven (7) days after the first advertisement was published; and
20	WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long
21	was placed in the aforesaid newspaper notifying the public of the second Public Hearing to be
22	held at least five (5) days after the day the second advertisement was published; and
23	WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described above
24	at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,
25	heard.

27	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
