Ordinance No. 0-98-97

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending subsection 26-50.1 of the Code of Ordinances relating to on-street parking in the Central City District, allowing such parking to be on areas designated by the City Manager and approved by the Florida Department Of Transportation; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a Public Hearing in the City Commission Auditorium in City Hall, City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held pursuant to the published notice described at which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Subsection 26-50.1(a) of the Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 26-50.1. Limited on-street parking - Central City District; hours permitted.

(a) On-street parallel parking shall be permitted in the Central City District on Main Street (SR 329) and University Avenue (SR 26) at the locations designated by the City Manager and approved by the Florida Department of Transportation ~~between North 2nd Avenue and South 2nd Avenue.~~

Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of

1 Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be
2 renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.

3 **Section 3.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid
4 or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no
5 way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

6 **Section 4.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
7 such conflict hereby repealed.

8 **Section 5.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon final adoption.
