



rather than spot zoning BA outside of the existing BA districts. A new business that sells all types of batteries, including golf cart batteries, could sell
golf carts as a related product under the new special use permit. The S.U.P.
should be limited to off-street, electric golf carts , so that on street vehicle
sales are not spread outside of BA districts.



We are family owned business based in Thomasville Georgia, and have been around 50 years with many changes over the years! We now have 12 company owned locations and hope to build our next store in Gainesville. We have developed through the years, a new unique type of a business plan that retails batteries in a way no one else is doing, which has been a large part of our success so far in a very competitive world. Our primary business is the retail sales of every type battery you can think of. In the Specialty, battery group, which are the smaller types, and some were not even around 10 or 15 years ago, from car remote batteries to camcorder batteries, cell phone batteries, laptop computer batteries, computer back up batteries, watch batteries and even that hard to find cordiess phone battery, we stock these and many more. This specialty battery group is the growth part our business, because cell phone places and electronic stores don't inventory a good stock of batteries and if they do, only for that year models and not last year's model, so it has created a good niche for us, we also sell traditional automotive and marine batteries and golf cart batteries and that portion of the business there is a lot of competition, but it takes it all to make it work. We also sell the Golf cart themselves which accounts for a small percentage of our business, but again, every little bit helps. Most of our business is carry out, but we do offer installation if our customer request which takes only 10 minutes and is a minor part of our business.

We keep limited employees at the store to keep overhead down, usually 2 and maybe 3 people. In order to keep limited amount of employee's we must be efficient; we run everything out of the front of the store, with no rear doors for theft and helps our efficiency to operate out of the front. We have bay doors with glass and nice white aluminum type frames. We utilize them for our commercial type customers that buy the larger batteries for bulldozers and other heavy equipment and such, they back their pickup truck up to these doors, we load them and they are gone. There are a lot of places they can buy these type batteries, but them like quickness they can get in and out of our store. We also receive pallet quantities through these doors.

We are one of the few retail type businesses that does not require much parking or traffic and usually our customers get what they want and are out of our store in 10 minutes or less. We are a nice clean operation, which customers require these days. Battery Source has created a niche that works well in the nicer part of town, and our best chance of success is to keep our Gainesville store the same as the other 12 that have proven to be successful!

Hope we can sell some batteries in Gainesville soon!
