

1 RESOLUTION NO. 051226

4 A resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida; amending
5 Resolution 050425, approved September 26, 2005, for the purpose of reallocating
6 fees paid for grave spaces and services at Evergreen Cemetery; providing a
7 repealing clause; providing an effective date.
8

9 WHEREAS, section 7-9 of the Code of Ordinances provides that prices for grave spaces
10 and services in the Evergreen Cemetery will be adjusted periodically based on review and analysis
11 of local market rates and that said rates will be adopted by resolution of the City Commission; and
12

13 WHEREAS, as part of the City's 2005-2006 budget process, on September 26, 2005 the
14 City Commission approved Resolution 050425 which increased certain user fees by 5% (effective
15 October 1, 2005); and
16

17 WHEREAS, on March 13, 2006 the City Commission voted to support the acquisition of
18 additional acreage for Evergreen Cemetery; and
19

20 WHEREAS, the funding for acquisition of additional acreage will come from future lot
21 sales that requires an amendment to the allocation of grave space sale prices.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
24 OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

26 Section 1. Paragraph 1 of Section 1 of Resolution 050425, regarding Fee Increase, is amended to
27 read as follows:

29 Section 1. Fee-increase Fees.

31 As of ~~October 1, 2005~~ May 1, 2006, the prices for grave spaces and allocation of total price for grave
32 spaces at the Evergreen Cemetery will be:

To the degree of conflict this Resolution supersedes all previous resolutions adopted by the City Commission on the matter of cemetery fees.


