10 **Section 4**. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the 11 application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the 12 other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional 13 provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption; provided however, the rates and charges as provided for herein shall be applicable, to all bills which are for the first time rendered and postmarked after 12:01 A.M., June 1, 2009.
