now owned by **THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA**, be acquired by the
State of Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, said use is in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation has
made application to said City to execute and deliver to the State
of Florida Department of Transportation a perpetual easement, or
easements, in favor of the State of Florida Department of
Transportation, for the purpose of constructing a stormwater
facility, sidewalks, seatwalls and retaining walls and maintaining
the stormwater facility, and said request having been duly
considered.

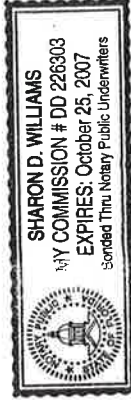
