COMPLAINT

The Plaintiff, AGNES BURKE, by and through the undersigned attorney, sues the Defendant, CITY OF GAINESVILLE, and states:

- 1. This is an action for damages in excess of \$15,000.00.
- At all times relevant to this action, the Plaintiff, AGNES BURKE, was a resident of Newberry, Alachua County, Florida.
- At all times relevant to this action, the Defendant, CITY OF GAINESVILLE, was a
 political subdivision of the State of Florida, with its principal headquarters in Alachua
 County, Florida.
- 4. At all times relevant to this action, the Defendant, CITY OF GAINESVILLE, owned and/or maintained and/or operated the Martin Luther King, Jr. Multi-Purpose Center, located at 1028 Northeast 14th Street in Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida.
- 5. On or about September 18, 2010, the Plaintiff, AGNES BURKE, was a business invitee at the Martin Luther King, Jr., Multi-Purpose Center and was lawfully on the premises for the purpose of attending a community event at that location.

- On or about September 18, 2010, while in the Martin Luther King, Jr., Multi-Purpose
 Center, the Plaintiff, AGNES BURKE, tripped on a tarp that was not properly secured to
 the floor.
- 7. At the time and place described above, the Defendant, CITY OF GAINESVILLE, owed a duty to invitees to the Martin Luther King, Jr., Multi-Purpose Center, including the Plaintiff, AGNES BURKE, to provide a safe area to walk.
- 8. At the time and place described above, the Defendant, the CITY OF GAINESVILLE, knew, or by the exercise of reasonable care, should have known, of the hazardous and unsafe condition of the tarp in the Martin Luther King, Jr., Multi-Purpose Center.
- 9. At the time and place described above, the Defendant, the CITY OF GAINESVILLE, willfully, recklessly, and/or negligently breached its duty of care in the following ways:
 - a. by failing to exercise proper care in maintaining the tarp in a safe condition for a business patron or invitee, including properly securing the tarp to the floor;
 - b. by failing to warn the Plaintiff of the dangerous condition of the tarp; and
 - c. by failing to properly hire and train employees to provide a safe walkway and a secure tarp on the floor for invitees.
- 10. As a direct and proximate result of the negligence by the Defendant, CITY OF GAINESVILLE, the Plaintiff, AGNES BURKE, has suffered bodily injury, and resulting pain and suffering, disability, disfigurement, mental anguish and pain, and aggravation of a previously existing condition and has incurred substantial medical expenses for treatment and care, past, present and future. These losses, injuries, and expenses are either permanent or continuing in nature and the Plaintiff, AGNES BURKE, will continue into the future.

- 11. Plaintiff, AGNES BURKE, gave written notice of the above-mentioned incident to the Defendant on October 12, 2010 by certified U.S. mail, pursuant to Florida Statutes §768.28.
- 12. More than 6 months have elapsed since notice was provided to the Defendant, and final disposition has not been reached.
- 13. The Plaintiff, AGNES BURKE, has satisfied all conditions precedent to bringing this lawsuit.

WHEREFORE, the Plaintiff, AGNES BURKE, demands judgment for damages in an amount exceeding \$15,000.00, together with the costs of this action, and further demands trial by jury on all issues so triable.
