WHEREAS, on this day the City recognizes mentors, parents and guardians, and donors involved in local mentoring programs and affirms its commitment to students; and


WHEREAS, we honor the Gainesville Enrichment Mentoring Program and Take Stock in Children for making the future brighter for our young people.
