WHEREAS, the health, safety, and comfort of this community greatly depend on the quality and effectiveness of the public works facilities and services; and

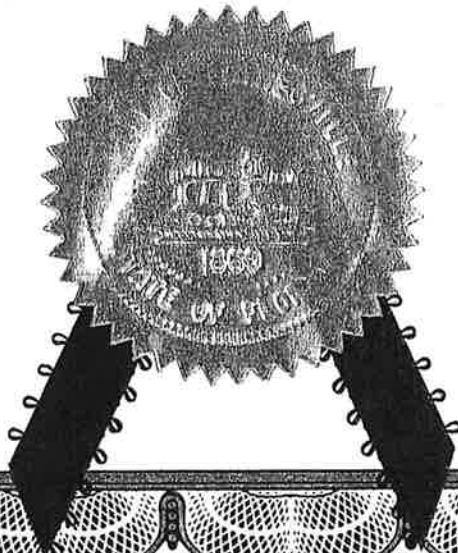
