


Basket of Services, Oct. 2007



Monthly Bill for All Services



Adopted FY 2007 Rates - 7,000 Gallons Residential Water Bill






Residential Natural Gas Bill Adopted FY 2007 Rates - 35 Therms



FY 2006 Fuel Adjustment and Sales






FY 2006 Fuel Adjustment and Levelization Balance







Purchased Gas Adjustment


- Divided into two seasons, Winter (April to September). (October to March) and Summer

- Gas penetration efforts increased heating uses. Historically higher cooking, drying, and water heat only number of customers with gas











