16	which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,			
17	heard;			
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE			
19	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:			
20	Section 1. Article III of Chapter 18, City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances, is hereby			
21	amended to read as follows:			
22	ARTICLE III. PUBLIC RECREATION <u>AND PARKS</u> BOARD *			
23	Sec. 18-36. Created; advisory to city commission.			
24	There is hereby created and established a public recreation and parks board which shall be			
25	advisory to the city commission.			
26	Sec. 18-37. <i>Powers</i> .			
27	The public recreation and parks board shall have the power to adopt rules and regulations for the			
28	proper conduct of public recreation for the city, subject to the approval of the city manager.			

- 1 Sec. 18-38. Composition; appointment of members; term; compensation.
- 2 (a) The public recreation and parks board shall consist of nine members appointed by the
- 3 city commission after the initial appointments for a term of three years each, or until their
- 4 successors are appointed and qualified.
- 5 (b) Additionally, the public recreation and parks board will consist of two ex officio
- 6 members; one appointed by the county school board and one appointed by the county
- 7 commission. These members will have no voting power and cannot be used for the purpose of
- 8 establishing a quorum for meetings.
- 9 **Sec. 18-39.** *Vacancies.*
- Vacancies in the public recreation <u>and parks</u> board shall be filled by the city commission for the
- 11 unexpired term.
- 12 Sec. 18-40. Election of chairperson and other officers; meetings.
- The members of the public recreation and parks board shall elect one of their number chairperson
- and shall elect other officers as may be necessary. The board, with the director of public
- recreation, shall meet once every three months and at such other times as the board or the
- chairperson shall deem necessary.
- 17 Sec. 18-41. Recommendations as to needs of city.
- 18 The public recreation and parks board shall advise the city commission and shall offer
- recommendations as to the needs of the city on all matters pertaining to recreation within the city.
- 20 Sec. 18-42. Gifts and donations.
- 21 The public recreation and parks board may solicit or receive any gifts or bequests of money or
- other personal property or any donation on behalf of the city commission, to be applied, principal

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1	or interest, for either temporary or permanent use for playgrounds or other recreational purposes,				
2	by the city commission.				
3	Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of				
4	this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of				
5	Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered				
6	or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.				
7	Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid				
8	or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way				
9	affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.				
10	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of				
11	such conflict hereby repealed.				
12	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.
