 Working closely with community support groups and Boards to create departmental 501 (c) (3) to meet the advocacy and fundraising needs of PRCA




- Research and monitor grant databases for potential funding opportunities for PRCA Master Plan and Vision 2020
- Establish grant "alerts" for grant opportunities in the eCivis and Foundation Directory online grant databases







 Worked closely with City Attorney to develop a new Scoreboard Sponsorship Program with new partner Sportable Scoreboards. Pilot project is for the Martin Luther King Multipurpose Center







- Secured funding for the Summer Heatwave Program crowdfunding fundraising campaign
- Developed a Grants Management calendar in Microsoft Outlook to manage grant proposal deadlines and fundraising activities

- Assisted with the development of an Adopt-A-Trail Agreement for local community groups

- Submitted the Facilities Assistance Form to the United States Tennis Association for the resurfacing of four tennis courts at the T.B. McPherson Park for reimbursement of up to 35% of project costs







 Submitted a \$5,000 grant proposal to TD Bank Foundation through a community partner Sisters Helping Sisters in Need, Inc. for new LED and motion sensor lighting at the Porters Community Center







 Submitted a \$10,000 grant proposal to the Plum Creek Foundation for a new shade structure to cover a portion of the Eastside Community Center playground







■ Submitted a \$50,000 grant proposal to the AEC Trust Foundation to implement an afterschool tutoring program through arts education for 1st, 2nd and 3rd grades at three City community centers through a partnership with Yopp, Inc.







 Submitted a \$500 grant proposal to the 2014 Pop Warner/Team Cheer Uniform and Apparel grant to support the Gator Cheerleading unit

- \$20,000 National Archives and Records Grants to support the digitization of the Evergreen Cemetery records, Deadline June 17th
