12	WHEREAS, in this past session, the Florida Legislature changed the dates and	
13	frequency for filing campaign finance reports which applies to municipal elections to the	
14	extent that the timing of the municipal election permits compliance with the timelines in	
15	the statute; and	
16	WHEREAS, the City Commission at its meeting of August 15, 2013, authorized	
17	the City Attorney to draft an ordinance changing sections of the City's Election Code	
18	relating to campaign finance reports; and	
19	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a	
20	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a	
21	Public Hearing in the Auditorium of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and	
22	WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held pursuant to the published notice	
23	described at which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be	
24	and were, in fact, heard;	
25	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION	
26	OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:	
27	Section 1. Chapter 9 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is	
28	amended to read as follows:	

CODE: Words stricken are deletions; words underlined are additions.

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à,	Sec.9-11.	Campaign contribution limitations; campaign finance reports.
2	(a)	Candidates shall not accept campaign contributions made by persons or
3		political committees as defined in F.S. § 106.011, political committees,
4		and committees of continuous existence in an amount exceeding \$250.00
5		per election per person or political committee. For purposes of this
6		section, a runoff election is considered a separate election. This limitation
7		does not apply to contributions from political parties.
8	(b)	Reports of all contributions received, and all expenditures made by:
9		(1) A candidate; or
10		(2) A political committee, as that term is defined in F.S. ch. 106, that has
11		made contributions or expenditures to influence the results of a city
12		election, shall be filed monthly once a campaign treasurer is appointed
13		and on the $32^{\text{nd}} 25^{\text{th}}$, $18^{\text{th}} 11^{\text{th}}$ and fourth days immediately preceding
14		the regular or special election, and, if a run-off is required, on the 25^{th} ,
15		11^{th} and fourth days immediately preceding the run-off election.
16	Section	n 2. It is the intention that Section 1 of this ordinance shall become and be
17	made a part of	the Code of Ordinances, of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the
18	Sections and F	Paragraphs of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order to
19	accomplish su	ch intentions.
20	Section	3 . If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this
21	ordinance or th	ne application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or
22	unconstitution	al, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the
23	ordinance whi	ch can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or
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1	application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.		
2	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the		
3	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.		
4	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final		
5	adoption.
