## CRITERIA FOR REVIEW OF LAND USE CHANGES

Staff reviewed this petition in the context of State Statues and the 11 factors stated in the Future Land Use Element for review of land use changes.

Policy 4.1.3 of the Comprehensive Plan states that "...The City will review proposed changes to the Future Land Use Map by considering factors such as, but not limited to, the following:

- . Consistency with the Comprehensive Plan
- Compatibility and surrounding land uses
- Environmental impacts and constraints
- 4. Support for urban infill and redevelopment
- 5. Impacts on affordable housing
- 6. Impacts on the transportation system
- 7. Availability of facilities and services
- 8. Need for the additional acreage in the proposed future land use category
- 9. Discouragement of urban sprawl as defined in Section 163.3164, F.S., and consistent with the requirements of Subsection 163.3177 (6)9, F.S.
- 10. Need for job creation, capital investment, and economic development to strengthen and diversify the City's economy
- 11. Need to modify land use categories and development patterns within antiquated subdivisions as defined in Section 163.3164, F.S
