15 16	WHEREAS, the Alachua County Property Appraiser certified the 2004 taxable
17	values to the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida on June 11, 2004.
18	WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires the City Commission to
19	advise the Property Appraiser of its rolled-back millage rate, its proposed millage rate,
20	and of the time, date, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the
21	proposed millage rate and the proposed tentative budget.
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
23	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
24	1. The rolled-back millage rate for general municipal purposes, as computed
25	pursuant to Section 200.065(1), Florida Statutes, is 4.7394 mills.
26	2. The proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative general
27	purpose municipal budget for the City of Gainesville's 2004-2005 fiscal year is 4.9416
28	mills.
29	3. A public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the
30	proposed tentative budget for general municipal purposes on Monday, September 13,
31	2004, at six o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City

1	Hall Auditorium on the first floor of City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, City of
2	Gainesville, Florida.
3	4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of this
4	resolution to the Alachua County Property Appraiser for use in preparing the Notice of
5	Proposed Property Taxes, as required by Section 200.069, Florida Statutes, and to
6	execute, as the Administering Official, any Department of Revenue forms necessary to
7	complete this certification.
8	5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
