17 18	WHEREAS, Chapter 90-496, Special Acts, Laws of Florida, created the "Alachua County	
19	Boundary Adjustment Act" which sets forth procedures for establishing municipal reserve areas and	
20	for adjusting the boundaries of municipalities through annexations; and	
21	WHEREAS, Chapter 90-496 was amended by Chapter 91-382 and Chapter 93-347	
22	Special Acts, Laws of Florida, (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Act") which requires a	
23	municipality to prepare and adopt by nonemergency ordinance, a report setting forth the plans to	
24	provide urban services to any reserve area prior to commencing the annexation procedures under	
25	the Act;	
26	WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville is planning to commence the annexation of certain	
27	unincorporated areas, as more specifically described in this Ordinance, that are located within its	
28	Reserve Area as defined in the Act and as redesignated by the Board of County Commissioners of	
29	Alachua County;	

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, at least ten days notice has been given prior to adoption by
publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed Ordinance
and of a Public Hearing to be held in the City Commission meeting room, First Floor, City Hall, in
the City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, Public Hearings were held pursuant to law, at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Urban Services Report, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein as if set forth in full, which sets forth the plans to provide urban services to an area generally north of NW 73rd Avenue and Sterling Place subdivision, east of the city limits, south of the city limits and west of the city limits in the vicinity of NW 43rd Street; is approved and adopted for that certain area as more specifically described in the Urban Services Report.

- **Section 2.** The City Manager is directed to commence the annexation of any portion or all of the area defined in the Urban Services Report, and the City Attorney and Clerk of the Commission are authorized to prepare and advertise the appropriate ordinance(s).
- **Section 3.** The Clerk of the Commission is directed to file a copy of this Ordinance and the accompanying Urban Services Report with the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County.
- **Section 4.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

2	such conflict hereby repealed.		
3	Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
