Even though I am only 23 years old, Gainesville has shaped me into the woman I am today. From the University of Florida molding me academically, to East Gainesville shaping my service-minded consciousness, to the many town halls on race and equity challenging me to transform ideas into tangible outcomes that consider every Gainesville citizen—even those who are considered in the shadows—this city is an inseparable part of my identity, as it will remain for the rest of my life.
