

Ordinance No. 050882  
Ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida; adopt an Urban Services Reimbursement Ordinance which sets forth the method by which the City shall provide urban services to an area comprised of parcels 06680-001-000, 06745-002-000 and 045-002-001, and generally located south of the City of Gainesville and Tax Parcel 06745-000, west of the vicinity of SW 42nd Avenue, north of SW 20th Avenue, and east of the City limits; the Ordinance is proposed for enactment by the City of Gainesville pursuant to Chapter 90-496, Special Laws of Florida, as amended, known as the Alachua County Boundary Adjustment Act; providing provisions to the City Manager, the City Attorney and Clerk of the Commission; providing a severability clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
