**PASSED June 2, 2016**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA, RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF PROJECT UNO AS A QUALIFIED TARGET INDUSTRY BUSINESS; AGREEING TO BUDGET AND APPROPRIATE UP TO FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000) AS LOCAL FINANCIAL SUPPORT IN THE QUALIFIED TARGET INDUSTRY TAX REFUND PROGRAM; PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the company under consideration is referred to as Project Uno; and

**WHEREAS**, Project Uno has requested, pursuant to Section 288.075(2)(a)(1), Florida Statutes, to maintain the confidentiality of information concerning its intention to locate part of its business activity in the City of Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to preserve the confidentiality of the information Project Uno seeks to keep confidential, and pursuant to Section 288.075(2)(a)(1), Florida Statutes, the Gainesville City Commission will keep confidential all such information until such information is no longer confidential under Section 288.075(2)(a)(1), Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, Project Uno intends to locate within the City of Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, Project Uno, in its new site, will employ 10 employees with an average annual compensation of \$42,482, per year; and

**WHEREAS**, Enterprise Florida, Inc. represents that the average private sector annual wage in Alachua County, Florida is \$36,941; and

**WHEREAS**, Project Uno intends to make a capital investment of \$130,000 over four years; and

**WHEREAS**, Project Uno, intends to apply for the Qualified Target Industry Tax Refund for 115% of average annual wage, pursuant to Section 288.106(3)(b)(2), Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the project is in the High Impact Sector and the City of Gainesville is providing the required local financial support to receive the High Impact Performance Incentive Grant (HIPI) bonus; and,

**WHEREAS**, the request by Project Uno has been reviewed by Enterprise Florida's primary economic development partner in Gainesville/Alachua County, the Gainesville/Alachua County Council for Economic Outreach and Gainesville Area Chamber of Commerce; and

1           **WHEREAS**, on May 24, 2016, the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners is  
2 tentatively scheduled to review funding 50% of the local financial support (\$5,000) towards this  
3 project; and,  
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5           **WHEREAS**, the Gainesville City Commission finds that the expenditure of City funds as  
6 local financial support for Project Uno constitutes a valid public purpose.  
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8           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE**  
9 **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FL:**  
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- 11 1. That the Commission finds, determines, and declares that the recitals in the preamble are true  
12 and correct, and hereby incorporates them by reference.  
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- 14 2. That in accordance with Section 288.106(4)(a)(10), Florida Statutes, the City Commission  
15 recommends that Project Uno, be approved as a Qualified Target Industry (QTI) Business.  
16
- 17 3. That the City of Gainesville has calculated that this project’s average annual wage of \$42,482  
18 is 115% of Alachua County’s average private sector annual wage as determined by Enterprise  
19 Florida.
- 20 4. That the City agrees to budget and appropriate up to \$5,000 as local financial support in  
21 Fiscal Year 2017 and running through Fiscal Year 2021 to the Florida Economic Development  
22 Trust Fund in the event Project Uno is certified as a QTI Business by the Department of  
23 Economic Opportunity and locates its business within the City of Gainesville corporate limits.  
24 The budgeted amount includes the Qualified Target Industry Tax refund and the High-Impact  
25 Sector refund.

- 27 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
