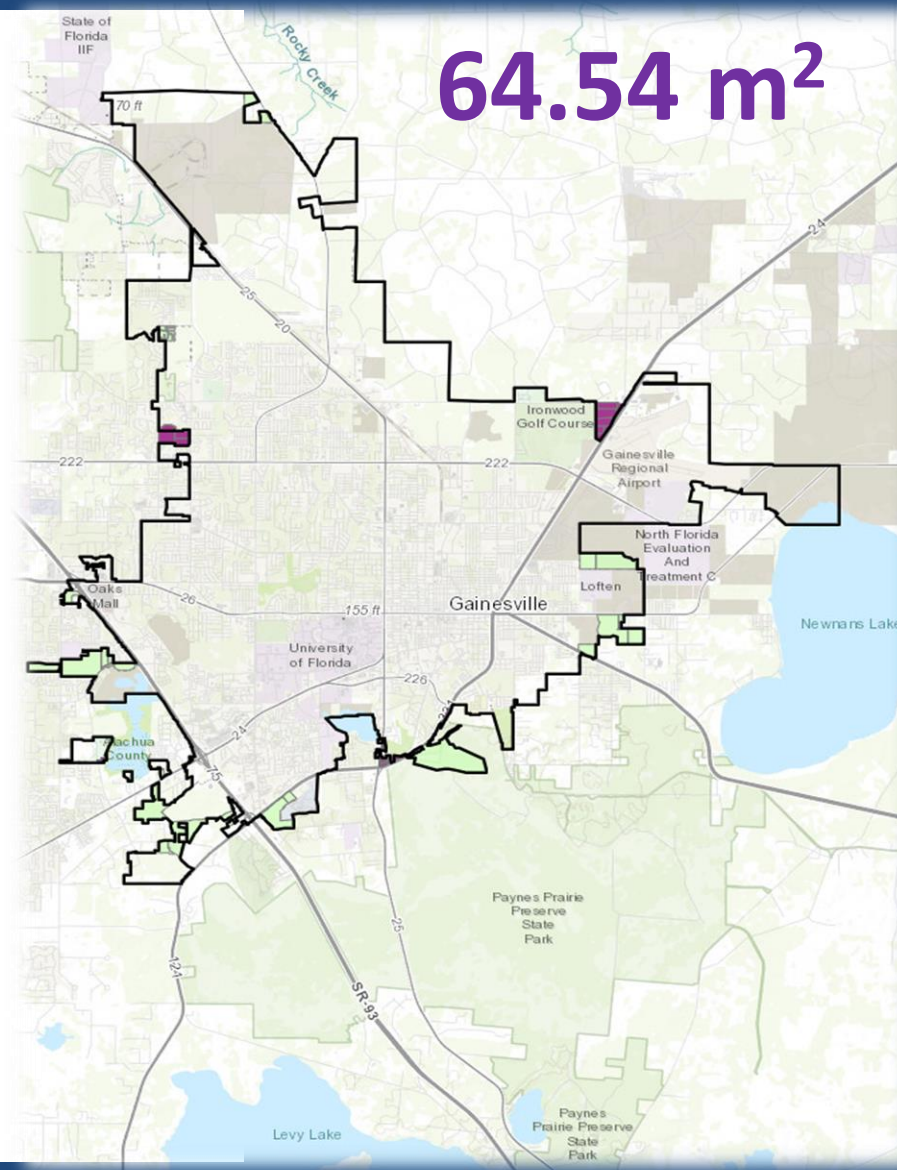

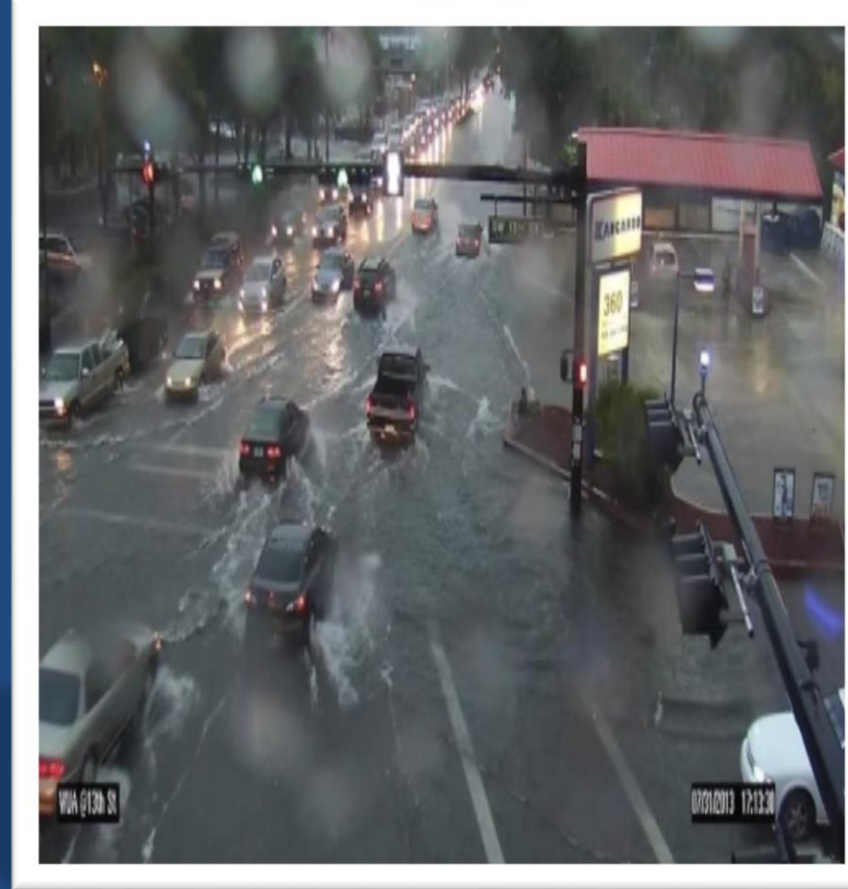
Outcome(s):

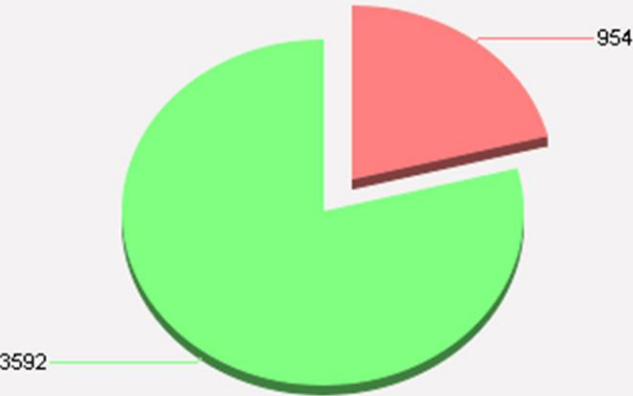

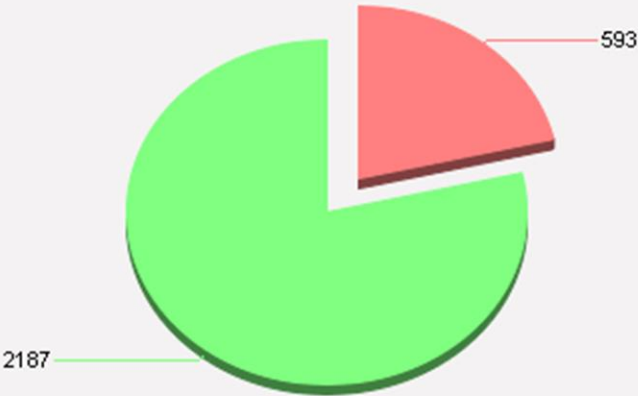
