AGREEMENT AND RELEASE BETWEEN ALACHUA COUNTY AND THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE REGARDING SETTLEMENT OF METAMORPHOSIS HOUSE APPEAL

THIS AGREEMENT AND RELEASE, made and entered into this day of June, A.D., 1997, by and between Alachua County, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the "County", and the City of Gainesville, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "City";

WITNESSETH:

whereas, the County filed an appeal of the City of Gainesville Plan Board's denial of a special use permit to allow improvements to a building located at 306 N.E. 7th Street, Gainesville, Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "property"; and,

WHEREAS, the County and the City wish to resolve and forever discharge any and all claims, issues, duties, rights, or
obligations as now exist or may arise as a result of the County's
application for and the City's approval of all permits pertaining to
the property. The County hereby releases and will bring no other
claim against the City relating to the property as a result of any
action occurring to that property prior to the date of this settlement agreement. By the execution of this agreement and its participation in the settlement negotiations that led to this agreement,
the City does not admit the merit of the County's claim and this

evidence of any liability or wrongdoing on the part of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and agreements as set forth herein, it is agreed as follows:

- 1. The City will pay the County up to the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00), payable as follows:
- a. Forty-five Thousand, Four Hundred Seventy-two and 55/100 Dollars (\$45,472.55) shall be paid to the County within thirty (30) days of the County's purchase of the Collins Court property.
- b. The City will contribute up to Fourteen Thousand, Five Hundred Twenty-seven and 45/100 Dollars (\$14,527.45) to the County for reimbursement of renovation expenses at Collins Court on a dollar-for-dollar basis with the County. Said sum shall be paid to the County within thirty (30) days of appropriate documentation and certification by the County Manager that the documented amount has actually been incurred.
- 2. The County will file a notice of voluntary dismissal of its appeal in City Plan Board Case No. 135 SUP-96PB, H.O. case No. HO-96-001, within fifteen (15) days of the execution of this agreement by the City and the County.
- 3. The City and the County shall bear their own costs and attorneys' fees incurred in City Plan Board Case No. 135 SUP-96PB.

, 4. This agreement contains all the terms and conditions agreed upon by the parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused this Agreement and Release between Alachua County and the City of Gainesville to be executed for the uses and purposes therein expressed on the day and year first above-written.

City Manager Wayne Bowers reviewed the recommendation.

FIRST MOTION - WITHDRAWN : Commissioner B. Delaney moved and Commissioner Calkins seconded to approve the City Manager's recommendation to contribute an amount not to exceed \$70,472.55 from the City Commission Contingency fund to the relocation project (later withdrawn).

SECOND MOTION - WITHDRAWN: Commissioner P. DeLaney moved and Commissioner B. Delaney seconded to contribute an amount of \$16,000 to the relocation project (later withdrawn).

THIRD MOTION - WITHDRAWN : Commissioner P. DeLaney moved and Commissioner B. Delaney seconded to contribute an amount of \$13,701.35 to the relocation project (later withdrawn).

FOURTH MOTION - WITHDRAWN: Commissioner Calkins moved and Commissioner Hanrahan seconded to contribute \$60,000 to the relocation project, \$30,000 from the City Commission Contingency fund and \$30,000 from another source to be determined by the City Manager (later withdrawn).

FIFTH MOTION :Commissioner Calkins moved and Commissioner Hanrahan seconded to authorize up to \$60,000, half from the City Commission Contingency fund and half from another source; and further, the second \$30,000 may be coming towards the end of the fiscal year when the City Commission can identify where that money might be left sitting in the City's budget.

Chairman Jennings recognized Citizen J.T. Frankenberger who spoke to the matter.

Commissioner Hanrahan requested an accounting both of last year's and this year's Community Development Department's budget, in terms of what was budgeted and what was spent, relating to long-term vacancies in the department.

Recommendation If the City Commission determines that the Metamorphosis House program should be moved from its current location, the City Manager's recommendation is to contribute an amount not to exceed \$70,472.55 to the relocation project.

A motion was made by Commissioner Calkins, seconded by Commissioner Hanrahan, that this matter be Approved, as shown above (Fifth Motion). The motion Carried by the following vote:
