Our law firm represents RBLWP Parcel D LLC (“Petitioner”), who is the owner of certain real property located at 1227 NW 4th Avenue, Gainesville, Florida (“Property”). On March 3, 2015, the City’s Historic Preservation Board rendered its Order denying the Petitioner’s Petition seeking a Certificate of Appropriateness to demolish a vacant, existing structure on the Property. On March 5, 2015, the Petitioner appealed the Historic Preservation Board’s March 3 Order to the City Commission for a *de novo* hearing (“Administrative Appeal”), and requested that such matter be scheduled on the City Commission’s meeting on March 19, 2015.
