10	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a			
11	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a			
12	Public Hearing in the City Commission Auditorium in City Hall, City of Gainesville; and			
13	WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held pursuant to the published notice described a			
14	which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact			
15	heard;			
16	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF			
17	THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA;			
18	Section 1. Chapter 14.5, Article III, Section 14.5-27, of the Code of Ordinances of			
19	the City of Gainesville, is amended to read as follows:			
20	Sec. 14.5-27. Application for wrecker operator's permit; violations.			
21	(a) No wrecker operator shall engage in trespass towing without first having obtained a			
22	wrecker operator permit from the owner of the company such operator is employed, or such			
23	owner's authorized designee. Each permit will meet the following specifications:			
24	(1) be not less than 2 1/8 inches by 3 3/8 inches.			
25	(2) contain a photograph of the wrecker operator that is not less than one inch by			
26	1 ½ inches in size.			

1	(3)	provide the name of the wrecker service and wrecker operator's first name in			
2		letters that are not less than 1/4 inch by 1/4 inch.			
3	(4)	provide a control number that is linked to the driver's personal information.			
4	(5)	provide a place for the chief of police or designee to validate the permit.			
5		a. After the permit is validated it shall be laminated to protect the			
6		information on the permit.			
7		b. If the permit is lost, damaged, stolen, becomes illegible or the permit			
8		holder changes wrecker services, the permit must be replaced. The			
9		replacement permit shall be valid only for the remainder of the time			
10		period for which the initial permit was valid.			
11	(b) It shall be unlawful for the owner of any wrecker service to permit any person to be				
12	employed as	wrecker operator conducting trespass towing within the city unless such			
13	person has been granted a wrecker operator permit to engage in trespass towing which has				
14	been validated by the chief of police or designee. Upon issuance of the permit, the wrecker				
15	operator is gr	nted the privilege of engaging in trespass towing within the city limits of the			
16	City of Gaine	ville, Florida, unless such permit expires or is suspended or revoked, as			
17	provided in the	s Article. Each permit shall be valid for two years from date of issuance.			
18	(c) In ord	r to secure a wrecker operator permit, an applicant must provide the following			
19	information o	a form provided by the city. The applicant must:			
20	(1)	Submit to the chief of police or designee a certified copy from the Florida			
21		Department of Law Enforcement of his/her criminal history and a certified			
22		copy of his/her driving record from the Florida Department of Highway			
23		Safety and Motor Vehicles;			

1	(2)	Possess a valid Florida Class E driver's license and provide a photocopy to		
2		the chief of police or designee.		
3	(3)	Not have been convicted, pled nolo contendere to, or had adjudication		
4		withheld for or been incarcerated after any conviction, plea of nolo		
5		contendere or adjudication withheld for any of the following:		
6		<u>a.</u>	Any capital felony, any first degree felony, sexual battery, any violent	
7			felony involving the use of a gun or knife or which results in great	
8			bodily harm.	
9		a <u>b</u> .	Within the previous ten years, Aany violent felony including rape,	
10			battery, aggravated battery, felony battery and aggravated assault not	
11			referenced in subsection "a" above.	
12		<u> </u>	Within the previous ten years, any felony or first degree misdemeanor	
13			directly related to the business of towing motor vehicles; repossession	
14			of motor vehicles; motor vehicle theft; car jacking or chop shops; or	
15			liens for recovering, towing, or storing vehicles and vessels (§713.78,	
16			F.S.).	
17		<u>e₫</u> .	Within the previous five years, of either: (1) driving under the	
18			influence of alcohol, a controlled substance, or a chemical substance,	
19			to the extent that normal faculties are impaired; or (2) driving with an	
20			unlawful blood alcohol level.	
21	(d) A peri	nit sha	ll be reviewed and granted or denied in writing within two business	
22	days. If the p	ermit i	s denied, the reason for such denial shall be provided in writing and	

1	shall also advise that the applicant may correct deficiencies in the application within 7 days					
2	of the notice of denial without incurring an additional application fee.					
3	(e) Permit fees shall be as provided in Appendix A, Schedule of Fees, Rates and					
4	Charges.					
5	Section 2. It is the intention that Section 1 of this ordinance shall become and be made					
6	a part of the Code of Ordinances, of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and					
7	Paragraphs of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such					
8	intentions.					
9	Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be					
10	invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no					
11	way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.					
12	Section 4 . All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent					
13	of such conflict hereby repealed.					
14	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately on adoption
