**PASSED July 24, 2006**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA; RELATING TO THE LEVY OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2006-2007 FISCAL YEAR; ESTABLISHING PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE; SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE TO THE ALACHUA COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Alachua County Property Appraiser certified the 2006 taxable values to the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida on June 9, 2006.

**WHEREAS**, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires the City Commission to advise the Property Appraiser of its rolled-back millage rate, its proposed millage rate, and of the time, date, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the proposed tentative budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** The rolled-back millage rate for the general municipal purpose, as computed pursuant to Section 200.065 (1), Florida Statutes, is 4.3083 mills.

**Section 2.** The proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative general purpose municipal budget for the City of Gainesville's 2006-2007 fiscal year is 4.9250 mills.


1           **Section 3.** A public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the

3 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City Hall Auditorium on the  
4 first floor of City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, City of Gainesville, Florida.

5           **Section 4.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of this  
6 resolution to the Alachua County Property Appraiser for use in preparing the Notice of Proposed  
7 Property Taxes, as required by Section 200.069, Florida Statutes, and to execute, as the  
8 Administering Official, any Department of Revenue forms necessary to complete this  
9 certification.


10           **Section 4.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

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
