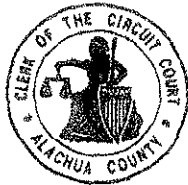

COMPLAINT FOR FALSE ARREST, MALICIOUS CONDUCT, FALSE
IMPRISONMENT, FALSE WRITTEN TESTIMONY, HARASSMENT

Plaintiff, brings forth the following civil charges against the defendants for \$500,000.00 (five hundred thousand dollars). The requested monies include monetary, physical, and emotional damages.

COMPLAINT

In 2007, the Plaintiff was physically assaulted by two individuals at his part time residence (girlfriend's house), to which; he properly defended himself. The assaulters included his girlfriend adult son, and a adult male friend of the son's.

The Gainesville Police Department (GPD) was telephoned (Plaintiff does not know by whom), to which; the officers arrived. I was falsely arrested with no evidence other than possessing a military ID and falsely charged. I asked the officer would my assaulters be arrested as well and was told, "no." I than asked the officer in a calm manner of how many person's would have to assault me before, I am allowed to protect myself, he laughed.

The individual who initiated the attack was charged and found guilty of forgery, passing fake cash, and other minor charges approximately a month later; as I was verbally informed.

I was later offered a plea bargain, which included deferred punishment without, no record, and freedom if I pled guilty, to which. I promptly refused and strongly instructed my attorney of my innocents. Furthermore,

I requested a speedy trial. However, due to my refusal of their unwarranted offer and my stance in regards to my innocence, my bill of rights was violated and my personal restrictions was extended beyond the Florida State statute maximum as a result, prior to dismissal.

PLAINTIFF DESIRED OUTCOME

Plaintiff, desires the defendants be ordered to right their wrong as follows;

1. The Plaintiff's desires that the unlawful arrest be permanently removed from all official/unofficial records.
2. The Plaintiff's desires that a permanent note be recorded in all involved personnel official personal files as too their involvement in the said case.
3. The Plaintiff desires monetary damages for harassment, unlawful arrest, false imprisonment, malicious conduct, physical, and emotional damages. The Plaintiff reserve the right to include attorney and all related fees and costs.

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
