Sec. 27-96. Definitions.

Connection charges shall mean a general term referring to the specific development charges that must be satisfied in order to receive water and/or wastewater service. For the purposes of this article, the following shall constitute \(\pi_{\text{w}}\) attention charges include: transmission and distribution, meter installation, water treatment plant, standby fire line, fire hydrant installation, inspection service fees, crossing charges and tapping fees. For the purposes of this article, the following shall constitute \(\psi_{\text{w}}\) astewater connection charges include: collection system, wastewater treatment plant, pumping station (primary and relay), force main (base system) charges, inspection service fees, and crossing charges, and tapping fees.

Sec. 27-128. Base rates for service

Rates and charges.

- (a) Rates. The rates to be charged and collected for water furnished by the city to consumers shall be in accordance with the schedule set out in Appendix A.
- (b) Surcharge for consumers outside corporate limits. The rates to be charged and collected from consumers of water furnished by the city to consumers outside the corporate limits of the city shall be the same as set forth above, plus a surcharge equal to twenty-five (25) percent. Surcharge for entities and consumers outside corporate limits. A surcharge equal to

The United States of America, the State of Florida and all political subdivisions, agencies, boards, commissions and instrumentalities thereof and all recognized places of religious assembly of the State of Florida are hereby exempt from the payment of the surcharge imposed and levied hereby.

Section 2. All ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

Section 3. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.

Section 4. If any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption; provided however, the rates and charges provided for herein shall be applicable as follows:

1) As to monthly bills for services described in Sections 27-128(b)(2) and 27-169(b)(2) of the Code, said charges shall be applicable to all monthly bills
