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An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances to revise the due date for payment for renewal of a landlord permit and the dates that late fees are assessed ; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date and a transition schedule.

WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a Public Hearing in the City Commission Auditorium in City Hall, City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held pursuant to the published notice described at which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

 - a. Application received on time and payment received on or before 10 business days of City finding all other permit requirements met 40.00

- 5 c. Application received 31 to 60 calendar days late or

8 requirements met 160.00
- 9 d. Application received 61 to 90 calendar days late or
10 payment received after 60 calendar days but on or before
11 90 calendar days of City finding all other permit

- 13 a. Payment received on or before January ~~December~~ 31

- 15 b. Payment received after ~~December~~ January 31 but on or
16 before ~~February~~ March 1 80.00
- 17 c. Payment received after ~~February~~ March 1 but on or
18 before ~~March~~ April 1 160.00
- 19 d. Payment received after ~~March~~ April 1 but on or
20 before ~~April~~ May 1 320.00

22 **Section 2.** It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of this
23 Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of

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1 Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be
2 renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.

3 **Section 3.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or
4 unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way
5 affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

6 **Section 4.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such
7 conflict hereby repealed.

8 **Section 5.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption, and shall apply to
9 all landlord permits and renewals of landlord permits that take effect on or after January 1,
10 2001.
