Resolution relating to membership in the Florida Retirement System

Recommendation: The City Commission adopt the proposed resolution.

At its meeting of November 13, 2001, the City Commission directed the City Attorney's Office to prepare the appropriate documents necessary to allow the Mayor and members of the City Commission to participate in the Elected Officers' Class in the Florida Retirement System. In order for the Mayor and members of the City Commission to participate in the Florida Retirement System, the City must commit to making contributions, executing agreements, and maintaining records, etc. associated with such participation. The attached Resolution is based upon a "model" form supplied by the Division of Retirement.

13	The City of Gainesville of Alachua County, Florida, in lawful session and in		
14	regular order of business properly presented, finds that:

16	WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida,		
17	to extend to the elected officials of said City of Gainesville, not excluded by law, the		
18	benefits of the Florida Retirement System, on the basis of applicable State laws and		
19	amendments thereto, and rules and regulations, authorizing and directing the City		
20	Manager to execute agreements thereto with the Department of Management Services,		
21	for coverage of only said elected officials; providing for withholding from salaries and		
22	wages of elected officials of the City of Gainesville so covered to be made and paid over		
23	as provided by applicable State laws or regulations; providing that said City of		
24	Gainesville shall appropriate and pay over employer's contributions and assessments as		
25	provided by applicable State law or regulations; providing that said City of Gainesville		
26	shall keep records and make reports as required by applicable State laws or regulations;

28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMISSION OF		
29	THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:		

Section 1. It is hereby declared to be the policy of the City of Gainesville,

2 Alachua County, Florida, that all its elected officials, except those excluded by law, shall

participate in the Florida Retirement System as authorized by Chapter 121, Florida

4 Statutes.

All elected officials shall be compulsory members of the Florida Retirement

System as of the effective date of participation in the Florida Retirement System so stated

herein.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute all necessary agreements and amendments thereto with the Administrator of the Florida Retirement System for the purpose of extending the benefits provided by the Florida Retirement System to the elected officials of this City of Gainesville as provided by Sections 1 and 2 hereof, which agreement shall provide for such methods of administration of the Plan by said City of Gainesville as are found by the Administrator of the Florida Retirement System to be necessary and proper, and shall be effective with respect to any service performed on and after March 1, 2002.

Section 3. Withholding from salaries, wages, or other compensation of elected officials for the purposes provided in Section 1 are hereby authorized to be made, and shall be made, in the amounts and at such times as may be required by applicable State laws or regulations, and shall be paid over to the Administrator designated by said laws or regulations to receive such amounts.

Section 4. There shall be appropriated from available funds, derived from ad valorem taxes and other appropriate revenue sources such amounts and at such times as may be required to pay promptly the contributions and assessments required of the City of Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida, as employer, by applicable State laws or regulations, which shall be paid over to the lawfully designated Administrator of the Florida Retirement System at the times and in the manner provided by law and regulation.

Section 5. The City of Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida, shall keep such records and make such reports as may be required by applicable State laws or regulations, and shall adhere to all laws and regulations relating to the Florida Retirement System.

Section 6. The City of Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida, does hereby adopt the terms, conditions, requirements, reservations, benefits, privileges, and other conditions thereunto appertaining, of the Florida Retirement System, for and on behalf of all elected officials covered under the agreement.

Section 7. The City Manager of the City of Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida, is hereby designated the custodian of all sums withheld from the compensation of elected officials as authorized herein and of the appropriated funds for the employer's contributions as provided in Section 4 hereof. Also, the City Manager is hereby designated the withholding and reporting agent and charged with the duty of maintaining records for the purposes of this Resolution.
